White's Tree Frog

Classification

Order: Anura

Family: Hylidae

Genera: Ranoidea

Species: Litoria Caerulea

Adult size: Female: 3" – 5"
 Male: 1-3"

Description

Lifespan: 10 – 15 years and more

Mutations: Green, blue, Snowflake, etc.

Climatic Parameters

Basking temperature: 26 – 28 degrees Celsius

Average temperature: 24 degrees Celsius

Cold side temperature: 22-23 degrees Celsius

Night temperature: 18-22 degrees Celsius

Humidity: 50 – 75 % (Reach 1-2 humidity highs of 75% per day, but allow humidity levels to drop to 55% between misting.)

Terrarium

Size: 18*18*24 (1-2 frogs of the same size)

Substrate: Organic soil, coco fibre (Zoo Med Eco Earth) or Jungle Mix (Zilla), topped with a layer of large leaf litter.

Lighting:

Heating: Incandescent heat bulb

UVB: T5HO 5.0 or Arcadia 6%

Feeding

Type: Insectivore

Prey: Crickets, wax worms, earthworms, silkworms, horned worms, roaches

Supplements: Calcium: On every insect for every meal
Multivitamins: 1x per week (Repashy Supervite, Reptivite Zoo Med), Vitamin A 1x per month (Repashy Vitamin A Plus)

Frequency: Feed 2-3 times per week

Hydration: A medium water bowl is needed for this species. Water must be changed every day,

Cohabitation

Recommended! White's tree frogs are a social species that enjoy the company of equal-sized individuals, provided that the terrarium is of appropriate size with enough resting areas.

Handling

Handling amphibians must be kept to a minimum. It is recommended to wash one's hands using a mild soap before any handling. Having wet hands during handling is equally as important in order to avoid removing the mucus on the animal's skin.
