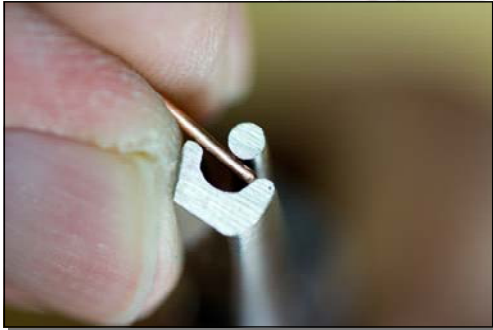
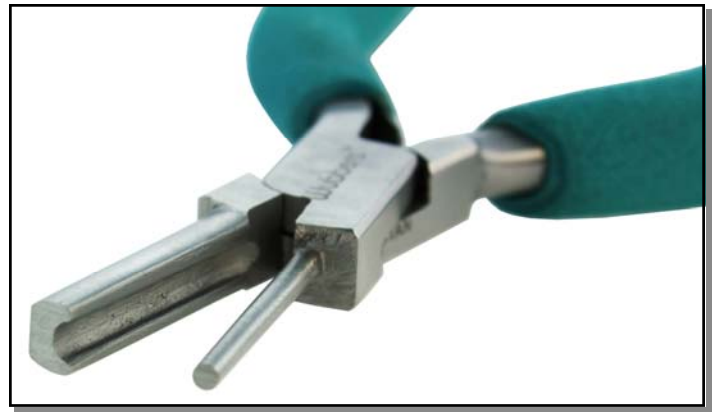
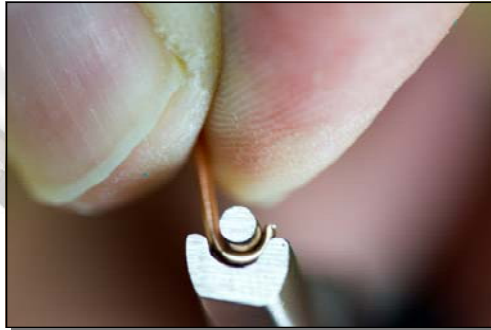


How 2 Form an Eyelet

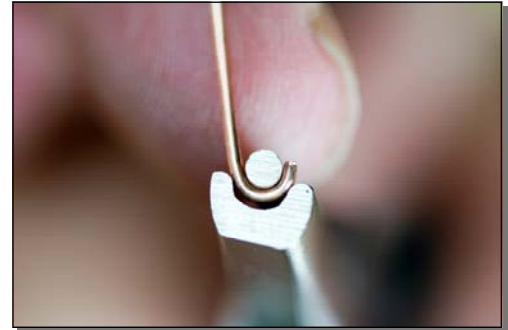
Round/Concave bending pliers
(Wubbers for example)
Jewelry wire



Step 1
Insert the wire in between the round and concave jaws of the pliers, resting the end against the inner jaw.



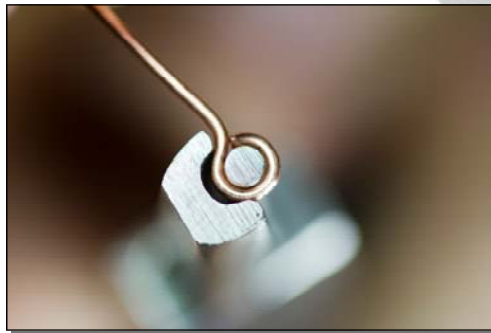
Step 2
Squeeze the jaws closed to start the U-bend in the wire.



Step 3
Use your fingers to hold and guide the wire as you bend.



Step 4
Rotate the pliers to bend the wire back on itself to make a complete loop.



Step 5
When the loop is closed, rotate the pliers back slightly allowing the concave jaw to bend the excess wire away from the loop,



Step 6
You now have an eyelet end. Just cut the excess wire to a desired length.
