Tricks of the Trade

When you design a garden to avoid deer damage, the most important considerations – the purpose of your garden and the overall look you desire- don't change. But you can accomplish most goals more than one way. Many of your favorite plants that deer greedily scarf down have relatively deer proof counterparts that can fulfill the same function. Do you long for spring-flowering bulbs? Then ditch the tulips and deploy daffodils. Need a shady spot in the summer yard? Fig, birch, horse chestnut, and mature common lilac trees will full the bill, not fill a deer's stomach. Need a hedge for privacy? Forget about such deer delicacies as hemlock and yew, and concentrate on junipers or rugosa roses.

Deer Repellants & Info

Apply different repellants about every 2wks or after a heavy rain.
