BELT by LANAS STOP 60% Acrylic, 40% Wool 100 g, 196 yards

KNITTING

HOW TO MAKE IT

MATERIALS:

• Belt, Lanas Stop: 2 balls: #257 Grape

• Knitting Needles Size 13

ABBREVIATIONS:

k = knit
rep = repeat(s)(ing)
p = purl
st(s) = stitch(es)

GAUGE:

22 sts = 4 in. (10 cm) over pattern. BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE. When you match the gauge in a pattern, your projecto will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficiente. It it takes you less stitches and rows to make a 4 in. [10 cm] square, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try larger size hook or needles.

SIZE: ONE SIZE About 8 1/2 x 60 in. (21.5 x 152.5 cm)

INSTRUCTIONS:

Cast on 47 sts.

Row 1 (RS): K3, *p1, k3; rep from *
to end of eow.

Row 2: K1, *p1, k3; rep from * across
to last 2 sts, p1, k1.

Rep Rows 1 and 2 until nearly all yarn
has been used (Scarf should measure
about 60 in. (152.5 cm) from beginning).
Bind off

FINISHING:

Weave in ends.
