















Crochet stitches:

ch = chain

ss = slip stitch

dc = double crochet

tr = trebles

.. = repeat

inc: increase by working two sc in the same st dec: decrease by working two sc together

What you need:

Hoooked Eco Barbante in different colour shades, approximately 50 grs in total.

Crochet hook

Sewing needle

Fiberfill Stuffing

Black beads or yam for the eyes

A little bit of pink yarn for the nose

Finished size: approx. 15 cm (from head to tail)

This pattern is worked in spiral, without closing each round.

Use a bit of yarn in a contrast colour to mark the beginning of the rounds. This will help you count the stitches and to follow this pattern.

Step 1: Crochet head and body

R1: Chain 2, work 6 dc into 1st ch (6).

R2: 2 dc in each stitch (12).

R3: *1 dc, 2 dc in the next stitch* repeat *...* (18).

R4: *5 dc, 2 dc in the next stitch* repeat *...* (21).

R5 - 7: 1 dc in each stitch (21).

Change the colour of the yarn. The first part will be the head.

R8: *6 dc, 2 dc in the next stitch* repeat *...* (24).

R9: 1 dc in each stitch (24).

R10: *7 dc, 2 dc in the next stitch* repeat *...* (27).

R11 - 15: 1 dc in each stitch (27).

R16: * 8 dc, decrease with 1 dc in next st* repeat *...* (24).

R17: * 7 dc, decrease with 1 dc in next st* repeat *...* (21).

R18: * 6 dc, decrease with 1 dc in next st* repeat *...* (18).

R19: * 5 dc, decrease with 1 dc in next st* repeat *...* (15).

Stuff the crochet piece firmly with fiberfill

before you continue with the last rounds.

R20: * decrease with 1 dc in next 3 st* repeat *...* (12).

R21: decrease in every stitch until the opening is closed.

Close with a ss and fasten off.

Step 3: Assemble the bird

Sew the wings and tail onto the body. Before you attach them pin them onto the body to establish their correct position. Take the leftover pink or peach yarn and cross stitch the nose onto the middle of the head. Then sew on 2 black beads to serve as eyes (alternatively you can cross stitch a bit of dark yarn instead of the beads).

In this table you will find conversion from UK to US crochet terminology: UK = US Double crochet = Single crochet Treble crochet = Double crochet 12 mm crochet hook = 16 crochet hook 60 cm = 23.62 inch



and stars to create a mobile pendant. Use a couple of meters of fishing line and hang the items on different levels.

Tip: Crochet multiple birds and other small items such as hearts

Step 2: Crochet 2 wings and a tail

The two wings and tail are made of 3 identical pieces.

R1: Chain 2, work 6 dc into 1st ch (6).

R2: 2 dc in each stitch (12).

R3: Crochet htr, tr, dtr together in 1st stitch, crochet 3 dc on the side of the dtr, *dc in the next stitch, 2 dc*. Repeat *...* (22).

R4: 2 dc, 2 dc in the next stitch, 1 dc, 4 ss, 3 dc, 2 dc in each stitch for the next 5 stitches, dc in last stitch. Close with a ss, leaving some excess yarn to sew on the parts onto the body.
