

Eucalyps

Eucalyps is an environmentally friendly and sustainable yarn made from eucalyptus trees. We only use trees from sustainably managed European forests. The production process is environmentally friendly and takes place in a closed loop: that means that all raw materials used during production are also reused. Eucalyps is ideal for crafting clothes and accessories. It's luxuriously soft, has a beautiful sheen, and is highly absorbent.

Eucalyps specifications

Approx. 100 grams Approx. 165 metres



4 - 5 mm











Pom Pom Baby Hat

Stitches used:

k = knit o = purl

k2tog = knit 2 together ssk = slip slip knit

You'll need:

- 4 mm circular needles
- 4 stitch markers
- 1 bobbin of Eucalyps in your main colour
- 1 bobbin of Eucalyps in your contrast colour
- Darning needle

Gauge: 20 sts = 10 cm

Sizes: Newborn (baby, toddler)

Brim:

Cast on 72 (80, 88) stitches in your contrast colour and join to work in the round. Place a stitch marker so you can see where the round ends. Work k1, p1 rib for 4.5 cm (5, 5.5 cm). Knit across for 1 round. This will be the folding edge of the brim. Work k1, p1 rib for 4 (4.5, 5 cm). Knit 1 across one more round.

Hat:

Switch to your main colour.

Knit across until the hat measures 11 cm (11.5, 12 cm) from the folding edge. Knit across one round, placing a stitch marker every 18 (20, 22) stitches. This will be where you work the decreases.

R1: *Ssk, k to 3 stitches before marker, k2tog, k1, slip marker* 4x

R2: Knit across

Repeat R1 and R2 until 4 sts remain per section, then bind off leaving a long thread. Use a darning needle to thread the remaining yam through the remaining stitches, pull tight and fasten off. Attach a pom pom and your hat is done!
