Eucalyps

Eucalyps is an environmentally friendly and sustainable yarn made from eucalyptus trees. We only use trees from sustainably managed European forests. The production process is environmentally friendly and takes place in a closed loop: that means that all raw materials used during production are also reused. Eucalyps is ideal for crafting clothes and accessories. It's luxuriously soft, has a beautiful sheen, and is highly absorbent.

Eucalyps specifications

Approx. 100 grams
Approx. 165 metres

TIP!

You can work a front post treble crochet by inserting your hook around the post, not in the top of the stitch.





Waffle Stitch Baby Blanket

Sizes:

- Newborn blanket: 90 cm x 90 cm
(35,10 inch x 35,10 inch)
= 9 bobbins
- Cradle blanket: 90 cm x 135 cm
(35,10 inch x 52,65 inch)
= 13 bobbins
- Toddler blanket: 100 cm x 150 cm
(39 inch x 58,50 inch)
= 16 bobbins

The number of stitches per size is indicated as follows: newborn (cradle, toddler).

- R1:** Chain 200 (200, 215). (This is a multiple of 3 + 5).
- R2:** Starting in the 4th chain from the hook, crochet 1 treble into each chain.
- R3:** Chain 2, * 1 FPtr, 2 tr* repeat until end.
- R4:** Chain 2, * 1 tr (on the FPtr from the previous row), 2 FPtr* repeat until end. This is the exact opposite row 3.

Repeat rows 3 and 4 until the blanket is the desired size. For the sizes specified in the pattern, that's a total of 64 (104, 116) rows. To add the finishing touch, add a double crochet border.

- R1:** Crochet around the blanket using double crochet.
- R2-10:** Crochet 1 dc in every dc, and 3 dc in the corner stitches.

Stitches used:

- ch = chain
dc = double crochet
t) = treble crochet
FPtr = front post treble
crochet

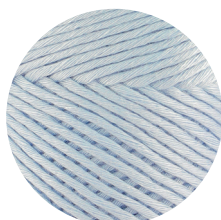
