SKILL LEVEL – Easy

SIZE

Finished Curved Top Edge About 64 in. (162.5 cm) Finished Length at Center Back About 21 in. (53.5 cm)

MATERIALS

- Lion Brand® Coboo (Art. #835)
 - 107 Denim 1 ball (A)
 - 109 Steel Blue 1 ball (B)
 - 106 Ice Blue 1 ball (C)
 - 149 Silver 1 ball (D)
- Lion Brand® stitch markers
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle



ADDITIONAL MATERIALS

Circular knitting needle size 7 (4.5 mm), 36 in. (91.5 cm) long

GAUGE

18 sts + 24 rows = about 4 in. (10 cm) in Stockinette st (k on RS, p on WS). BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

STITCH EXPLANATION

yo (yarn over)

An increase that also creates a small decorative hole (eyelet) in the fabric, worked as follows:

- 1. Bring yarn to front, between the needles.
- 2. Take yarn to back, over the right needle. This creates the new st. You are now ready to proceed with the next st as instructed.

NOTES

- 1. Shawl is worked in one piece from back neck downwards.
- 2. After the first few rows, 4 rows of Stockinette st (k on RS, p on WS) alternate with 6 rows of Garter st (k every st of every row) and Eyelet Rows are worked every 10th then every 20th row.
- 3. Yarn over increases are worked to shape the Shawl.
- 4. The first st of every row is slipped and the last st is purled. This creates neat edges on the Shawl.
- 5. When the pattern tells you to slip a st, slip as if to knit or as if to purl, whichever look you prefer.
- 6. A circular needle is used to accommodate the number of sts. Work back and forth in rows on the circular needle as if working on straight needles.

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Note: The following corrections have been incorporated into the pattern below. We are highlighting the corrections separately here so that if you have printed out an earlier version of the pattern you'll know what was changed.

CORRECTIONS (applied April 4th, 2019)

SHAWL

. . .

Row 8: SI 1, k to last st, p1. p to end of row.

SHAWL

With A, cast on 3 sts.

Row 1 (RS): SI 1, yo, k1, yo, p1 – you will have 5 sts in this row.

Row 2: SI 1, k3, p1.

Row 3: SI 1, yo, k3, yo, p1 – 7 sts.

Row 4: Sl 1, k5, p1.

Row 5 (Eyelet Row): Sl 1, *yo, k1; rep from * to last st, yo, p1 – 13 sts.

Row 6: SI 1, p to end of row.

Row 7: Sl 1, yo, k to last st, yo, p1 - 15 sts.

Row 8: SI 1, p to end of row.

Row 9: SI 1, yo, k to last st, yo, p1 – 17 sts.

Row 10: Sl 1, k to last st, p1.

Rows 11-14: Rep Rows 9 and 10 twice – 21 sts in Row 13.

Rows 15-24: Rep Rows 5-14 – 49 sts in Row 23.

Row 25 (Eyelet Row): Sl 1, *yo, k2; rep from * to last 4 sts, yo, k3, yo, p1 – 73

sts.

Rows 26-34: Rep Rows 6-14 – 81 sts in Row 33.

Row 35: Sl 1, yo, k to last st, yo, p1 – 83 sts.

Rows 36-44: Rep Rows 6-14 – 91 sts in Row 43.

Row 45 (Eyelet Row): Sl 1, *yo, k3; rep from * to last 3 sts, k2, yo, p1 – 121 sts.

Rows 46-54: Rep Rows 6-14 – 129 sts in Row 53.

Rows 55-74: Rep Rows 35-54 – 193 sts in Row 73.

Row 75: Sl 1, yo, k to last st, yo, p1 – 195 sts.

Rows 76-78: Rep Rows 6-8 – 197 sts in Row 77.

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Change to B.

Rows 79-84: Rep Rows 9-14 – 203 sts in Row 83.

Row 85 (Eyelet Row): Sl 1, *yo, k4; rep from * to last 2 sts, k1, yo, p1 – 254 sts. **Rows 86-94:** Rep Rows 6-14 – 262 sts in Row 93.

Rows 95-104: Rep Rows 35-44 – 272 sts in Row 103.

Row 105 (Eyelet Row): Sl 1, *yo, k4; rep from * to last 3 sts, k2, yo, p1 – 340

sts.

Rows 106-108: Rep Rows 6-8 – 342 sts in Row 107.

Change to C.

Rows 109-114: Rep Rows 9-14 – 348 sts in Row 113.

Row 115-124: Rep Rows 35-44 – 358 sts in Row 123.

Row 125 (Eyelet Row): Sl 1, *yo, k6; rep from * to last 3 sts, k2, yo, p1 – 418 sts.

Rows 126-134: Rep Rows 6-14 – 426 sts in Row 133.

Change to D.

Rows 135-144: Rep Rows 35-44 – 436 sts in Row 143.

Row 145 (Eyelet Row): Sl 1, *yo, k6; rep from * to last 3 sts, k2, yo, p1 – 509 sts.

Rows 146-154: Rep Rows 6-14 – 517 sts in Row 153. Bind off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.

beg = begin(ning)

k = knit

p = purl

rep = repeat

RS = right side

sl = slip

st(s) = stitch(es)

WS = wrong side
