

Noro Striped Scarf – Jared Flood/Brooklyn Tweed



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Materials

Yarn: 220 yds (200 m) 2 balls in each of two colors of Noro Silk Garden or any other self-striping worsted weight yarn.

Needles: US size 7 (4.5mm) straight needles.

Finished Measurements: 5.5 inches (14 cm) wide x 5 to 6 ft (150-180 cm) long.

Notions: Scissors, tapestry needle.

Abbreviations/Terms

BO – Bind off

CC – Contrasting color

CO – Cast on

K – Knit

MC – Main color

P – Purl

Sl 1 – Slip 1

Wyif – With yarn in front

Sts – stitches

Pattern Notes

This is Jared Flood's [Noro Scarf Pattern](#), specified here to make a scarf 5.5 inches wide.

Pattern Instructions

With MC, CO 39 sts.

Setup row: With MC, sl 1 wyif, (k1, p1) to last 2 sts, end k1, sl 1 wyif.

Row 1: With CC, (k1, p1) to last st, end k1.

Row 2: Sl 1 wyif, (k1, p1) to last 2 sts, end k1, sl 1 wyif.

Rows 3 - 4: With MC, repeat rows 1 and 2.

Repeat Rows 1-4 until scarf measures desired length.

BO in pattern on the second row of a stripe of either the MC or CC.

Break yarn, weave in ends.
