## **Materials**

White Digital Double Border Y4288-1	¾ yd
Inner Border: Lt Red Diagonal Plaid Y4293-4	¼ yd
Outer Border: Lt Teal Digital Peekaboo Hearts Y4292-103	% yd
Binding: Teal Dots Y4295-104	⅓ yd
Suggested Backing: Multi Digital Floral Y4290-55	1¾ yds

## Cut the Fabrics

Please read entire pattern before cutting fabrics.

From Double Border: Centering the design, trim to measure 12 ½" x 43".

From Red Diagonal Plaid cut: (3) strips 2" x WOF

From Teal Peekaboo Hearts cut: (4) strips 4 ½" x WOF

From Teal Dots cut: (4) strips 2 ½" x WOF

## Things to Know

- Please note some fabrics are directional
- WOF= width of fabric
- LOF= length of fabric
- RST= right sides together
- Sew all seams at 1/4"
- Always press seams toward darker fabric

## Instructions

- 1. Measure to confirm the length of the trimmed Double Border. Select two of the Red Diagonal Plaid 2" inner border strips. Trim these to the measured center length. Sew one of these strips to each side of the center. Press. Measure the unit from side to side. From the remaining WOF strip, cut two 2" inner border strips to this measurement. Sew to the top and bottom edges of the center panel unit. Press.
- 2. Select two Teal Peekaboo Hearts 4 ½" strips for the outer border. Stitch short ends to create one long strip. Measure the center unit length. From the long strip cut two borders for the left and right sides of the quilt. Stitch and press. Measure the resulting unit width. From the remaining border strip, cut two more borders to this width. Sew these to the top and bottom edges. Press.

Tips: (1) Note the location of the seam and decide where you would like it to appear in the border - either near the center or closer to the quilt edge - before cutting side borders.

(2) Note the direction of the hearts when attaching borders.

- 3. Select the (4) Teal Dots 2 ½" binding strips. Sew these strips end to end using a diagonal seam to reduce the bulk. Press seams open. Press & fold the binding lengthwise.
- 4. Layer backing, batting and top and quilt as desired.
- 5. Bind.
