Divine Chocolate, started in 1998, is a Fairtrade chocolate company co-owned by the Kuapa Kokoo co-operative of cocoa farmers in Ghana. The farmers (both men and women) receive not only a fair price for their cocoa but share the company profits which is 45% owned by the co-operative.

Among its various awards, in 2018 Divine Chocolate was chosen to receive the Queens Award for Enterprise in Sustainable Development for its innovative and successful business model which empowers both farmers and consumers to ensure a sustainable future.

Divine Chocolate produces a variety of chocolate bars including organic bars, snack bars, boxed chocolates as well as cocoa and drinking chocolate made with 100% cocoa butter without using palm oil, soya and GMOs.
