Community Crafts Association of the Philippines (CCAP) is a fair trade organization based in 11 provinces in the Philippines. CCAP empowers approximately 900 artisans in 31 different community-based groups.

Not only are these artisans receiving fair wages and safe working conditions, CCAP also offer Business Development Services (ie. Training sessions and mentorships) through which the artisans may improve their entrepreneurial skills.

Some workshops included in the Business Development Services are Basic Financial Management, Marketing, Production Management and Quality Control, among many others.
