When these two breweries get together, they're united by a shared obsession of boundary pushing hazy beers. It's called 'Infamous Life', loaded with an irresistible amount of Krush and Mosaic hops. It bursts layers of mango, citrus, nectarines and apricots, with a slight whiff of creamy malt.

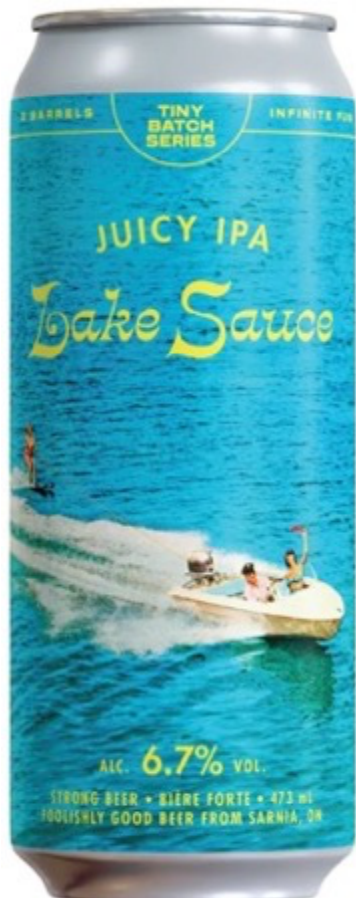

Located in the Fraser Valley in southwestern British Columbia, Camp is a community-based brewery and tasting room. It's 100% locally owned, with strong grassroots in the world of homebrewing. This unique IPA is brewed with a fusion of fresh pineapple puree, coconut, vanilla and a touch of lactose. It's classified as a Milkshake IPA, leaning into a tropical dessert, without losing all of its juicy-hop goodness.

The Establishment Floating Vibes

The Establishment is a brewery and taproom located in Calgary's growing Barley Belt brewing district. The team behind this brewery has always had a great passion for beer, so we're always on high alert for every release. 'Floating Vibes' is a monster of an IPA, with a kick of booze. At 8.2% abv, it's a little dangerous because it's so juicy, like a perfectly succulent cloud, ready to sweep you off of your feet.

Moody Blood Orange

Dan and Adam started Moody Ales to share their enthusiasm for craft beer with exciting flavours. Homebrewing is where it all began, and they eventually opened their own facility in 2014. This beer is brewed and released as a yearly summer seasonal. It's a hazy and fruity Weiss beer, infused with tangy blood orange juice and Mandarina Bavaria hops. All the creamy breakfast cereal malts shine, with an explosion of citrus and a hint of clove and coriander.

Style: West Coast IPA

Continuing with a nice rhythm, is another collaboration between Boombox Brewing and Changing Colours Brewing out of BC. It's called 'CD-R', which is a perfectly balanced West Coast IPA, that certainly won't disappoint. The hop bill includes El Dorado Salvo, Cryo Simcoe, Mosaic, Cryo Mosaic and Sultana hops. It's tart and tangy, offering notes of grapefruit, mango, pineapple, passionfruit and a nice vibe of pine.
