Backcountry Nuke It From Orbit

The team behind Backcountry Brewing joined forces in 2015, when they realized they each had a different piece of the puzzle to opening a new brewery. Located in Squamish, they have found a nice groove in BC's craft beer scene. 'Nuke It From Orbit' is a big West Coast IPA and part of their Limited Release Series. It bursts a good kick of tropical fruit, with a creamy malt base and a hint of piney resin and citrus.

Four Winds Super Lemon Haze

Situated just off the banks of the Fraser River in Delta, is a small brewery owned by the Mills Family. They opened their doors in 2013 and certainly play an important role in the BC Craft World. 'Super Lemon Haze' is a beer brewed with botanically-derived plant terpenes. This allows the team to recreate the aroma and flavour of the Super Lemon Haze cannabis strain, without using any THC related products.

Small Gods is a family owned-and-operated brewery, designed to fit into the community of Sidney by the Sea. Sidney is a tiny seaside village, beside the Swartz Bay ferry, that connects South Vancouver Island to the mainland. 'At The Bay' is a Hazy IPA, featuring a blend of Alora and Solero hops. The Alora hop brings waves of nectarine and citrus, that dance perfectly with Solero's tropical punch of pineapple and mango.

Inspired by the spirit of the Calgary '88 Olympics, Eighty-Eight Brewing opened their doors to the public in August 2018. Located in Inglewood, they've added some well-needed excitement of big flavours to the area. 'SPF '88' is an explosive IPA, that you shouldn't think twice about lathering up, for ultimate freshness. HBC 1019 and Sabro hops make up the hop blend, with the addition of coconut and punchy pineapple.
