Superflux Beer Company is a fantastic brewery nestled between Strathcona and East Vancouver. With this location, they're joining a number of other breweries, that have had beer lovers flocking to this area for a while now. 'Bristol' is a West Coast IPA, with HBC638 and Citra Cryo hops, making up the hop bill. It's also brewed with flaked rice, for a lighter body and certainly bursts a mix of tropical fruit.

Field House Brewing is a community-focused craft brewery located in East Abbotsford. Established in 2015, they have certainly built a reputation for producing 'top notch' beers, leaning towards perfection. This latest release is a bright pale ale, featuring a fusion of Simcoe and Strata hops. It's layered with notes of tangerine, clementine, pineapple and grapefruit, with a touch of pine. A gentle hoppiness brings it all together, on the finish.

When these two breweries get together, they're united by a shared obsession of boundary pushing hazy beers. This hazy is called 'Fluffy Tufts' and it showcases the elite New Zealand Motueka hop. It's packed with a rich mix of mango, papaya and delicious cereal milk.

Mike Clark and Luke Pestl spent several years brewing in the Toronto beer industry before branching out to open their own place. This all came together in April 2012 with Bellwoods opening as a small brewery and pub in downtown Toronto. 'Ghost Orchid' is a magnificent IPA, named after the highly pleasing and rare flower, responsible for the Nelson Sauvin hop. It's loaded with a mix of juicy tropical fruit and a soft piney bitterness, that sings away with joy.
