Loire Valley, France

Bright and fresh, this wine is made from 100% Melon de Bourgogne, also known as Muscadet. It reveals a jazzy mix of lemon, lime, tart apple and yellow pear.

Languedoc-Roussillon, France

For the most part, the whites from Bruno Lafon are unoaked, showing all that is pure and clean about Chardonnay. It carries a mix of tropical fruit and citrus.

Finca Monica

Rioja, Spain

Made from Tempranillo, this energetic red is showing excellent spirit for a traditional Rioja wine. It's loaded with fresh cherries, ripe plum and tea spices.

Sindicat La Figuera

Montsant, Spain

The Montsant wine region is located inland from the coast, in northern Spain. This elegant and fruit-forward wine, is made from pure Garnacha (Grenache).
