Camp Cloud Cover

Style: Tropical IPA

Located in the Fraser Valley of BC, Camp is a community-based brewery and tasting room. It's 100% locally owned, with grassroots in the homebrewing community and a strong passion for craft beer. 'Cloud Cover' is a foggy hop drop, brewed by head brewer, Dave Henry. He's brewed this beer with three of his favourite hops, for an ultimate explosion of flavour. You'll taste a mix of tropical fruit with lots of juiciness.

Twin Sails Juice Plus
British Columbia
Style: India Pale Ale

This brewery was founded by twin brothers Cody and Clay Allmin and is located adjacent to Yellow Dog Brewing and just down the street from Moody Ales. A very impressive brewing district, to say the least. 'Juice Plus' is a 100% Citra hopped IPA, roughly based on their delicious 'Dat Juice' recipe. They simplified the malt to let the juicy hops shine and added more Citra pellets and powder.

This beer is an ultra-refreshing Lager, hopped with Motueka, Citra and Southern Cross Hop Kief hops. The grain bill also has flaked rice and corn added, for an extra crisp body. It's wonderfully crushable, offering notes of lemon, lime and white grape.

Category 12 Deviation
British Columbia
Style: Irish Stout
473ml

Founder and head brewer, Michael Kuzyk, has been brewing beer for more than 25 years. After leading the creation of several world-class research labs, he decided it was time to make his own magic. 'Deviation' is his interpretation of a classic dry Irish Stout, with a gentle twist. The rich flavours of roasted malts are rounded out with the addition of vanilla. The end result, is a smooth and easy-drinking stout, revealing notes of chocolate and a creamy spike of vanilla.

Pile O' Bones
Saskatchewan
Style: White IPA
473ml

The owners of Pile O' Bones chose this name to remind people of the fact that many diverse Indigenous tribes, once hunted buffalo here for thousands of years. They did this to support life on the prairie and called the hills of Saskatchewan home. This beer is classified as a White IPA, which is basically a wheat beer that's been generously hopped. It carries a creamy mix of citrus fruits, with a hint of malt and coriander.
