Languedoc-Roussillon, France

Chardonnays from the South of France, while not as famous as those from Burgundy, always seem to offer a solid ease, associated around a clean finish.

Red Vinho Verde, although extremely rare, will certainly entertain your taste buds. This fruity example is made from 100% Vinhao, showcasing the freshness.

Puerto Del Monte

Bierzo, Spain

Bierzo is a wine region in the northwest corner of Castilla y Leon, specializing in a grape varietal known as Mencia. It's like a basket full of berries with licorice.

Pair with Paella or Pastrami Sandwiches



Garofoli Serra Del Conte

Marches, Italy

Verdicchio is certainly a grape varietal we don't see very often. This example is incredibly juicy and vibrant, bursting fuzzy peach, mango and citrus blossom.

Pair with Steamed Clams or Cod Fritters



Levert Freres

Beaujolais Villages, France

This wine is made from 100% Gamay. It carries dried sage and leafy tea on the nose. On the palate, the wine reveals juicy plum, cherry jam and elderberry.

Pair with Chicken Tagine or Pork Tacos



Chateau Pegau Cuvee Setier

Cotes-du-Rhone Villages, France

This wine is a fleshy and succulent blend of Grenache, Syrah and Mourvedre. It carries an explosive taste of black plum, blackberry and pepper.
