Brewsmith Pub Ale Alberta Style: Pale Ale 473ml

Nestled in the vibrant neighbourhood of Bowness, Brewsmith is all about brewing exceptional beers that bring people together. Their Head Brewer. Colin James, made his mark in Calgary, when he worked with The Dandy Brewing Company. Now, he's certainly excited to share his own project, built on passion. His 'Signature Pub Ale' is a delightful introduction. exhibiting a mingle of dark fruits. nutty malt and roasted caramel.

Superflux Sea King British Columbia Style: Hazy IPA 473ml

Superflux Beer Company is a fantastic brewery nestled between Strathcona and East Vancouver. With this location. they're joining a group of other breweries, that have had beer lovers flocking to this area for a while now. 'Sea King' is a hazy IPA brewed with large amounts of flaked oats and wheat, for a light but very thick and juicy haze. The hop bill includes a mix of Columbus Cyro, Citra, Eclipse and exp16660.

Backcountry Still Got The Old Tagger On It British Columbia

Style: West Coast IPA

Located in Squamish, they have found a nice groove in BC's craft beer scene. This West Coast IPA was brewed with aggressive doses of Idaho 7 and El Dorado Hops. It showcases a fusion of exotic fruit, watermelon jolly rancher and pine with a hint of creamy malt.






Establishment Collab Alberta Style: Vienna Lager 473ml

Keeping it interesting for you in November, is a collaboration between The Establishment Brewing from Calgary and Burdock Brewing from Toronto. This latest offering is their version of a Vienna Lager, which pays tribute to the original Vienna ale that hails from Austria. It's a malty lager, reminding us that clean and crisp is always a great option. You'll taste a mix of cereal grains, citrus and grape with a hint of caramel malt.

Bellwoods Jelly King Ontario Style: Fruited Sour 473ml

Mike Clark and Luke Pestl spent several vears brewing in the Toronto beer Industry before branching out to open their own place. This all came together in 2012, with Bellwoods opening as a small brewery and pub in downtown Toronto. This limited version of the 'Jelly King' is a varied fermentation lightly hopped ale, soured with a 5-strain blend of lactobacillus. It's also finished with a mix of tart cranberry and fresh tangerine.
