







Located in Squamish, they have found a nice groove in BC's craft beer scene. 'I Wonder If It Remembers Me' is a juicy and hazy pale ale, hopped with Citra and Eldorado hops. It offers a fusion of orange zest, grapefruit and guava with a candied-like sweetness.



Style: West Coast IPA

Jean Francois Gravel began homebrewing in 1991 and quickly became enamoured by the craft. When he met Stephane Ostiguy during an internship at the Armand-Frappier Institute, they decided to open a microbrewery in Quebec. This beer called 'Dent De Requin' or 'Shark Tooth', is a highly aromatic West Coast IPA. It's tart and tangy showcasing a mingle of citrus, kiwi, mango, passionfruit and orange, with a hint of pine and caramel.
