They're located right in the heart of the Manchester Brewing District, in Calgary and a short walk from a very impressive line-up of breweries. This beer called 'Stargazer', is brewed for big thinkers, late nights and anyone who's ever stared at the sky and ordered another beer. The hop bill includes a thrilling mix of Galaxy, Solero and Centennial.

Four Winds Tumbo

Situated just off the banks of the Fraser River in Delta BC, is a small brewery owned by the Mills family. They opened their doors in 2013 and have always played an important role in the BC Craft World. 'Tumbo' is a juicy and hazy pale ale, hopped with Amarillo, Galaxy and Eclipse hops. It offers a fusion of orange zest and ripe peach with a creamy mouthfeel. A little bite on the finish, also adds the perfect melody.

Jean Francois Gravel began homebrewing in 1991 and quickly became enamoured by the craft. When he met Stephane Ostiguy during an internship at the Armand-Frappier Institute, they decided to open a microbrewery in Quebec. This beer called 'Petite Morale' or 'Little Moral', is a highly aromatic IPA. It's tart and tangy showcasing a mingle of citrus rind, grapefruit, mango and passionfruit with a hint of pine and sweet caramel malt.

Small Gods is a family owned-and-operated brewery, designed to fit into the community of Sidney by the Sea. Sidney is a tiny seaside village, beside the Swartz Bay ferry, that connects South Vancouver Island to the mainland. 'Rascal King' is probably one of their most popular beers, blending an explosion of Citra, Mosaic and Azacca hops. It's glorious and smooth, highlighting a harmony of tropical fruit and zippy orange.
