Located in Inglewood, they've added some well-needed excitement of big flavours to the area. 'Pleasure Principle' is a nod to a song by Janet Jackson in the 80's. It's a hazy IPA hopped with a mix of Citra-Cryo, Dolcita and Rakau hops. Shake off the night and embrace the juicy flavour of stone fruits.

The historic village of Elora is located in the province of Ontario. In 2016, the Elora Brewing Company was opened after a massive transformation of a beautiful, 160-ish year-old limestone building. This beer called 'Lady Friend', is a new IPA release to Alberta and a beauty to boot. The hops are present for sure but nicely tempered with some malt. You'll also taste a mingle of citrus, passion fruit, honey and spruce tips.



Superflux Coconuts

Superflux Beer Company is a fantastic brewery nestled between Strathcona and East Vancouver. With this location, they're joining a group of other breweries, that have had beer lovers flocking to this area for a while now. 'Coconuts' is definitely a twist from your standard hazy IPA. It's soft and creamy, heavily hopped with a unity of Vic Secret and Citra hops. It's then conditioned on a voluptuous bed of coconuts, for extra pop.

Style: Session IPA

Located in Sarnia, Refined Fool Brewing Co has certainly come a long way from their humble beginnings, using DIY converted maple syrup drums, to brew their own magic. This beer called 'Leotard Party', is certainly very crushable, sitting at only 4.5% abv. It's classified as a Session IPA, which is a lighter and more sessionable version of a standard IPA. Fresh citrus and melon shine here, with a hint of grassy hops.
