'88 In The Sun  
Alberta  
Style: West Coast IPA

Inspired by the spirit of the Calgary '88 Olympics, Eighty-Eight Brewing opened their doors to the public in August 2018. Located in Inglewood, they've added some well-needed excitement of big flavours to the area. In collaboration with Dageraad Brewing, 'In The Sun' is a classic West Coast IPA, with the addition of pomelo zest. It's crisp and energizing, offering a mix of citrus, grapefruit, pine and a nice kick of malt.

Twin Sails Sonne  
British Columbia  
Style: Hefeweizen

This brewery was founded by twin brothers Cody and Clay Allmin and is located adjacent to Yellow Dog Brewing and just down the street from Moody Ales. A very impressive brewing district, to say the least. 'Sonne' is a Bavarian-style wheat beer, with 100% German barley and wheat malts. Hallertau hops are also added to the mix, for subtle notes of orange zip and a moderate spiciness.

Style: Imperial Hazy IPA

## Île Sauvage British Columbia Style: Hazy Pale 473ml

Located in Victoria, Île Sauvage is French for 'Wild Island' and is a dual reference to the wilderness of Vancouver Island and their focus on the wild side of beers. This new release to Alberta is called 'Brume De Mer'. It's a Hazy Pale that certainly offers a huge punch of goodness. This is due to sea buckthorn berries, lemon verbena and Citra hops being added to the beer. You'll taste a hazy fusion of tropical fruit and a good citrus bite.

## Backcountry British Columbia Style: Hazy IPA 473ml

The team behind Backcountry Brewing joined forces in 2015, when they realized they each had a different piece of the puzzle to opening a new brewery. Located in Squamish, they have found a nice groove in BC's craft beer scene. 'Pop Quiz, Hot Shot' is a Hazy IPA that has enough Citra, El Dorado and Idaho 7 hops, to put a hole in the world. It carries loads of dank orange, jolly rancher, papaya, and passion fruit.
