Bellwoods Bellweiser

Mike Clark and Luke Pestl spent several years brewing in the Toronto beer industry before branching out to open their own place. This all came together in April 2012, with Bellwoods opening as a small brewery and pub in downtown Toronto. 'Bellweiser' is a crisp Pilsner that fits the bill perfectly, giving you a tiny break to cleanse the palate. It carries a slight citrusy, floral hop note, with a refreshing mix of apple and white grape on the finish.

Main Street
British Columbia
Style: West Coast IPA

Tucked into an historic heritage building that was formerly the heart of the Vancouver brewing scene in the late 1800s, Main Street has been producing tasty beers since 2014. This classic West Coast IPA nicknamed 'Naked Fox', brings together Cascade, HBC 682 and Talus hops. The hops are present for sure but nicely tempered with some malt. You'll also taste a mingle of citrus, passion fruit, honey and fresh cedar.
