You'll taste a mix of lychee, tangerine, citrus and a hint of grassy pine.

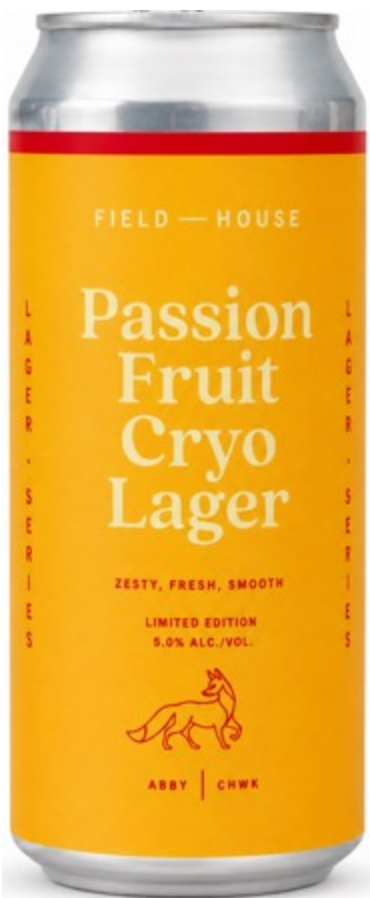


Refined Fool Hazy Roy

Superflux Beer Company is a fantastic brewery nestled between Strathcona and East Vancouver.
