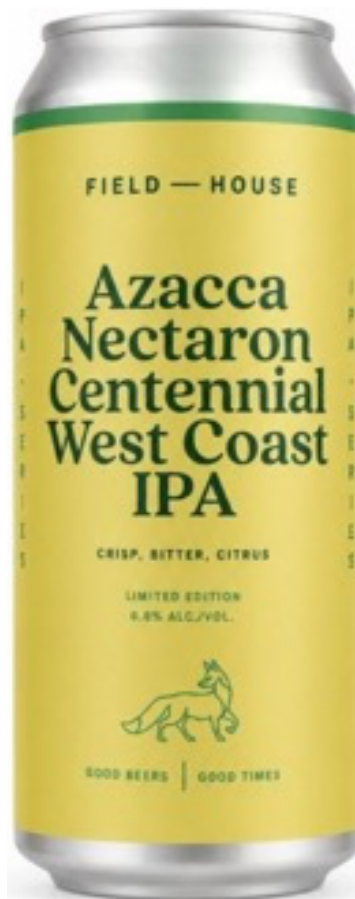

Located in Inglewood, they've added some well-needed excitement of big flavours to the area. 'Head Over Heels' is another classic Hazy IPA, featuring a blend of Idaho 7, Nelson, Citra and Mosaic hops. Like a cold slurpee on a summer day, this beer is just for you. It's loaded with a mingle of tropical fruit goodness.

Field House Brewing is a community-focused craft brewery located in East Abbotsford. You'll taste layers of pineapple, peach, lime juice and mango, with a good punch of pine resin and bready malt.

Changing Colours

Style: Lite Lager

Changing Colours Brewing Project is currently being brewed out of PoCo Brothers Brewing, in Port Coquitlam. The owner, Miquel Molina, independently owns this venture, renting tank space to brew his own magic. This beer nicknamed 'Howdy Cerveza', is brewed with 100% Canadian malt and a touch of corn. It carries a slight citrusy, floral hop note, with a stimulating mix of apple and white grape, on a clean finish.
