Inspired by the spirit of the Calgary '88 Olympics, Eighty-Eight Brewing opened their doors to the public in August 2018. Located in Inglewood, they've added some well-needed excitement of big flavours to the area. 'Fast Times' is considered a small or session-style Hazy IPA, clocking in at only 3.5% abv. This is a lighter and more sessionable version of a standard IPA. Fresh citrus and melon shine here with mellow hops.

Cabin Brewing began manufacturing 'rockstar' beers in 2018. They're located right in the heart of the Manchester Brewing District, in Calgary and a short walk from a very impressive line-up of breweries. This beer called 'Daydream', is a juicy blend of Olicana, Superdelic, Ekuanot and Dolcita hops. You'll taste a dynamic blast of citrus, guava, jackfruit, mango and passion fruit, with a soothing, pillowy haze.
