

# Ute Mountain Pottery

Ute Mountain Trading Company (UMITC) is a contemporary pottery created by the Ute and Navajo people in their homeland the Southwestern United States. Each piece is individually casted and hand cleaned. The artists of UMITC take pride in the fact that the design work on every piece is unique.

The Ute and Navajo artists do not use guides, stencils or replicate preconceived patterns. As a result, from the gentle blending of colors to employing traditional and contemporary designs, each pottery piece is unique. On each piece the artist signs their name, tribal affiliation, U.S.A. and Ute Mountain Tribal Seal.

The Native American artisans of UMITC desire their contemporary pottery to reflect their heritage and creativity and to be functional as well. All glazed pieces are safe for food and drink. They should be hand washed separately. Pottery glazed on the inside is suitable for planting, treat dishes, etc. As only U.S. Government approved Lead-Free glazes are used. UMITC people are proud of their work and are confident that this piece of Native American art will please you for years to come.
