

# Rainbow Clouds



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#### **Materials**

1 Fuzz Family Baby Feet Sock Custom Bundle
MC - 433 yds
CC1, 2, 3, 4 & 5 - 80 yds each
Size 3 US (3.25mm) 32" or 40" needle

## Gauge

21 sts = 4"

### Finished Dimensions

56" wide by 13" high

#### Notes

The garter edge seems to be offset, but in reality the way that the k1fbs line up at the ends of each row will make for even 3- stitch edges. All stitches are slipped with the yarn on the WS of the work.

#### Pattern

With MC, cast on 3 sts using the long tail method. Knit 21 rows. Without turning, rotate work 90 degrees clockwise and pick up 10 garter bumps along the side edge. Rotate 90 degrees clockwise once more and pick up the three cast on stitches. Knit 1 WS row (16 sts).

Row 1 (RS): k2, k1fb, k1fb, k to last 5 stitches, k1fb, k1fb, k3 (20 sts).

Row 2: knit all stitches.

Repeat these two rows until you have 160 stitches. Don't cut MC. Now you will begin the clouds pattern.

Row 1 (RS): With CC1, k2, k1fb, k1fb, k1, \*slip 2 stitches with yarn in back, k2\* repeat between stars until last 7 stitches, slip 2 stitches with yarn in back, k1fb, k1fb, k3 (164 sts).

Row 2: k5, p2, \*slip 2 stitches with yarn in front, p2\* repeat between stars until last 5 stitches, k5 stitches. Don't cut CC1.

Row 3: With MC, k2, k1fb, k1fb, k to last 5 stitches, k1fb, k1fb, k3 (168 sts).

Row 4: Knit all stitches.

Row 5: With CC1, k2, k1fb, 1kfb, k3, \*slip 2 stitches with yarn in back, k2\* repeat between stars until last 5 stitches, k1fb, k1fb, k3 (172 sts).

Row 6: k5, p4, \*slip 2 stitches with yarn in front, p2\* repeat between stars until last 7 stitches, p2, k5

Row 7: With MC, k2, k1fb, k1fb, k to last 5 stitches, k1fb, k1fb, k3 (176 sts).

Row 8: Knit all stitches.

Still using CC1, repeat rows 1-8 twice more and then rows 1-4 once more. You will have 7 rows of clouds in CC1 216 sts).

Using CC2, work rows 5-8 of the clouds pattern. Then work rows 1-8 twice, followed by rows 1-4 once more. You will have 6 rows of clouds in CC2 (264 sts).

Using CC3, work rows 5-8 of the cloud pattern. Then work rows 1-8 twice. You will have 5 rows of clouds in CC3 (304 sts).

Using CC4, work rows 1-8 twice. You will have 4 rows of clouds in CC4 (336 sts).

Using CC5, work rows 1-8 once, then rows 1-4 once more. You will have 3 rows of clouds in CC5 (360 sts).

After all the cloud rows are completed, bind off all stitches knitwise on the RS loosely.

Block by soaking in lukewarm water for about 20 minutes, squeeze out excess water, then lay flat to dry.
