

GMG Cowl



Materials

1 bump of Gedifra Giotto Molto Grande
Size 50 US straight or circular needles

Notes

This is worked flat in seed stitch and then seamed together at the ends. Finished dimensions before seaming are approximately 50" long by 8" wide.

"Seed stitch" refers to the pattern where you always knit the purls and purl the knits as they face you. Garter stitch instructions are also given. Both versions are completely reversible and the wrong side will be determined by the seam that is created when you attached the ends.

Pattern - seed stitch version as shown

Cast on 9 sts using the long tail method.

Row 1: k1, p1, k1, p1, k1, p1, k1, p1, k1

Repeat row 1 until piece is approximately 50" long, leaving at least a yard of yarn for seaming and weaving in ends. Bind off.

Pattern - garter stitch version (not shown)

Cast on 8 sts using the long tail method.

Row 1: knit all stitches

Repeat row 1 until piece is approximately 50" long, leaving at least a yard of yarn for seaming and weaving in ends. Bind off.

Both versions - finishing

Use mattress stitch to seam the cast on edge to the bind off edge, then weave in both the cast on tail and the bind off tail into the seam.

Wrap your new cowl around your neck for some light, lofty and incredible warmth!
