



Materials

2 skeins of Sister Ananse Worsted

- color A - spectrum 2.0
- color B - spectrum pink

Size J US crochet hook

Finished Dimensions

approximately 57" long x 12" deep
exact gauge is not crucial

Abbreviations

ch(s) - chains

sk -skip

st(s) - stitches

dc - double crochet

sc - single crochet

rep - repeat

Notes

- The starting chain of every row counts as a stitch.
- Shawl begins with color A in cobweb stitch and finishes with color B for border in spider filet.

Pattern

Foundation: In color A, ch 30. Sk 3 ch (counts as 1 dc), dc 3 in 4th ch, dc to last ch, dc 4 in last ch

Setup row: Ch 3 and turn, dc 3 in first st, sc in next st, *sk 2 sts, (dc, ch 1, dc, ch 1, dc) in next st, sk 2, sc * rep between * across to 2nd to last st, sc, dc 4 in last st

Row 1: Ch 3 and turn, dc 3 in first st, sk 1, sc, sk 1 *(dc, ch 1, dc, ch 1, dc) in sc, sk the first dc and ch in the fan, sc in the center dc, sk the other ch and dc in the fan* rep across to the last st, sc 4 in the top of the ch

Repeat row 1 sixteen more times (19 total rows including foundation and setup) until you have 141 sts. Break yarn and fasten off.

Join color B at the fasten off point, ch 3 and dc 2 in the same st as join. Dc across every st and ch to last st. 3dc in last st. 145 sts.

Row 1: Ch 3 and turn, dc 2 in first st, dc 11, ch 5, sk 1, *dc 14, ch 5, sk 1* repeat to last 12 sts, dc 11, dc 3 in last st

Row 2: Ch 3 and turn, dc 2 in first st, *dc to 2 sts before the ch, ch 4, sc in the middle ch, ch 4, sk 2 dc* rep 8 more times, dc to last st, dc 3 in last st

Row 3: Ch 3 and turn, dc 2 in first st, *dc to 2 sts before the ch, ch 5, sc 3 starting in the ch before the previous sc and ending in the ch after it, ch 5, sk 2 dc* rep 8 more times, dc to last st, dc 3 in last st

Row 4: Ch 3 and turn, dc 2 in first st, *dc to ch, dc 2 in ch sts, ch 4, sc in the center st of the previous 3, ch 4, dc 2 into the far chs* rep 8 more times, dc to last st, dc 3 in last st

Row 5: Ch 3 and turn, dc 2 in first st, *dc to ch, dc 2 in ch sts, ch 1, dc 2 into the far ch sts* rep 8 more times, dc to last st, dc 3 in last st

Row 6: Ch 3 and turn, dc 2 in first st, dc across to last st, dc 3 in last st

Final Row: Ch 1, *sc, sk 1, (dc, ch 1, dc, ch 1, dc) in next st, sk 1* rep to last st, sc

Break yarn and fasten off.

Weave in ends.

Block by submerging in lukewarm water, using a color catcher if necessary, for about 20 minutes. Gently squeeze water out and lay flat to dry, stretching gently into shape. You may wish to use pins or blocking wires to really open up the spider detail.
