Mecha Mistake Rib Cowl



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Materials

2 skeins of Malabrigo Mecha Size 13 24" circular needles

Pattern

Cast on 72 stitches. Place marker and begin working in the round, being careful not to twist your stitches.

Begin mistake rib pattern:

Row 1: *k2, p2* repeat until end of round

Row 2: k1, *p2, k2* repeat between * until 3 stitches remain, p2, k1

Repeat these two rows until you have used most of the second skein. Save plenty of yarn for binding off and seaming. Before blocking, the cowl looks like a long, skinny, tube. Bind off very loosely knitwise and weave in all ends on one side of the cowl. This side will be the wrong side of the piece.

Submerge cowl in cool water in the sink with wool wash, taking care not to agitate. Gently squeeze out excess water and lay out to dry. Cowl should block to approximately 17 inches wide and 16 inches long.

After the cowl is dry, fold it in half, wring side in, and seam the cast on edge to the bind off edge. Weave in the ends. Wear cowl with seam on the inside.
