



Speckle Dipped Knit Hat

Materials

1 Speckle Dipped Kit by Kraeo Fuzz Family

- 1 MC skein (DK, 231 yds)
- CC1, CC2, CC3 & CC4 minis (DK, 57 yds ea)

Size 5 US 16" circular needles

Size 6 US 16" circular needles

Size 6 US double point needles

Finished Dimensions

approximately 9.5" tall x 8" wide when flat
exact gauge is not crucial

Abbreviations

ssk - slip 2 stitches, one at a time, knitwise, then knit together into the back of them

k2tog - knit 2 stitches together

psso - pass slipped stitch over and off the needle

Notes

This year, we decided to keep it super simple and have fun blending speckles. Whether you knit, crochet or Tunisian crochet, we hope you enjoy working these patterns with whatever yarn you choose!

Pattern

With CC1 and smaller circular needles, cast on 104 stitches. Place marker and join in the round, taking care not to twist. Begin rib section:

Rnd 1: *p1, k1* repeat between stars to marker

Rnds 2-8: repeat rnd 1

Join CC2

Rnd 9: *p1, k1* repeat between stars to marker

Rnds 10-14: repeat rnd 9, alternating CC1 & CC2

Cut CC1

Rnds 15-20: with CC2, repeat rnd 9

Join CC3

Rnd 21: *p1, k1* repeat between stars to marker

Rnds 22-26: repeat rnd 21, alternating CC2 & CC3

Cut CC2

End ribbing section. Brim is approximately 3.5".



Switch to larger circular needles.

Rnd 27: with CC3, *p1, k1, p1, k23, pm* repeat between stars twice more, then p1, k1, p1, knit remaining 23 stitches to the end of round

Rnds 28-32: with CC3, *p1, k1, p1, k23, sm* repeat between stars three times more to end of round

Join CC4

Rnd 33: *p1, k1, p1, k23, sm* repeat between stars three times more to end of round

Rnds 34-38: repeat rnd 33, alternating CC3 & CC4

Cut CC3

Rnds 39-44: with CC4, repeat rnd 33

Join MC

Rnd 45: *p1, k1, p1, k23, sm* repeat between stars three times more to end of round

Rnds 46-50: repeat rnd 45, alternating CC4 & MC

Cut CC4

Continue in pattern with MC until length of hat from cast on is 9". Begin decreasing, switching to the double points as necessary to manage the stitches.

Rnd 1: *p1, k1, p1, k5, ssk, k2tog, k5, ssk, k2tog, k5, sm* repeat between stars to end of round (88 sts)

Rnd 2: *p1, k1, p1, knit to marker* repeat between stars to end of round

Rnd 3: *p1, k1, p1, k4, ssk, k2tog, k3, ssk, k2 tog, k4, sm* repeat between stars to end of round (72 sts)

Rnd 4: repeat round 2

Rnd 5: *p1, k1, p1, k3, ssk, k2tog, k1, ssk, k2tog, k3, sm* repeat between stars to end of round (56 sts)

Rnd 6: repeat round 2

Rnd 7: *p1, k1, p1, ssk, ssk, sl 1, k1, psso, k2tog, k2tog, sm* repeat between stars to end of round (32 sts)

Rnd 8: *p1, k1, p1, ssk, k1, k2tog, sm* repeat between stars to end of round (24 sts)

Cut yarn, pass through all remaining stitches and fasten off. Weave in all ends. Block and add a fun pom if desired!



Speckle Dipped Crocheted Fingerless Mitts



Materials

1 Speckle Dipped Kit by Kraeo Fuzz Family

- 1 MC skein (DK, 231 yds)
- CC1, CC2, CC3 & CC4 minis (DK, 57 yds ea)

Size H crochet hook

Finished Dimensions

S/M (M/L) approximately 10.5" tall x 3 (3.5)" wide when laying flat
exact gauge is not crucial

Abbreviations

ch - chain

sc - single crochet

dk - double crochet

fpdc - front post double crochet

sk - skip

Notes

Color changing: For a clean color break, stop at the last step of the stitch (2 loops on hook for sc) and pull through with the new color.

Front post double crochet: A double crochet worked around the post of the stitch rather than the top; achieved by inserting the hook from the front of the work to the back just to the right of the stitch, and then from back to front to the left of the stitch.

Be mindful of stitch count, especially during the set-up row. Make sure you're working around the correct stitch post, and be careful not to skip too many sc. If stitch count is off after the setup row, double check these particular things.

Size adjustment: The raised rib pattern works over a multiple of 3 sts + 1. To resize the mitts smaller or larger, ch a multiple of 3 + 2 and sk 1st ch.

Ends: Since you will change colors so often, you might find it best to work over your tails as you go. Lay the tail over the tops of the stitches and crochet over them. This will be during rib rows more often than not, but the skipped stitch will not matter too much in the long run.

Pattern

With CC1, ch 26 (29).

First row (RS): Sk 1st ch, sc in every ch across. Ch 1 and turn. 25 (28) sts

Next row (WS): Sc across. Ch 1 and turn.

Set-up row (RS): Sc 3, *fpdc around sc from first row below next sc. sk the sc behind dc, sc 2* repeat between stars across to the last 4 sts. Fpdc as before, sc last 3 sts. Ch 1 and turn.

Next row (WS): Sc across. Ch 1 and turn.

Raised Rib Stitch

Row 1 (RS): Sc 3, *fpdc around dc 2 rows below. Sk the sc behind dc, sc 2* repeat between stars across to the last 4 sts. Fpdc as before, sc last 3 sts. Ch 1 and turn.

Row 2: (WS): Sc across. Ch 1 and turn.

Repeat these two rows 16 times in total, following the color pattern below:

- 2 repeats in CC1 (including set-up rows)
- 1 repeat in CC2, 1 repeat in CC1. Cut CC1
- 2 repeats in CC2
- 1 repeat in CC3, 1 repeat in CC2. Cut CC2
- 2 repeats in CC3
- 1 repeat in CC4, 1 repeat in CC3. Cut CC3
- 2 repeats in CC4
- 1 repeat in MC, 1 repeat in CC4. Cut CC 4

Work 16 rows even of sc, then repeat the set up row for one last row of rib at the top cuff. Fasten off, leaving a long tail for seaming.

Seam along the long edge, leaving a gap for the entire thumb. Weave in ends and block if desired.

Speckle Dipped Tunisian Crocheted Cowl

Materials

1 Speckle Dipped Kit by Kraeo Fuzz Family

- 1 MC skein (DK, 231 yds)
- CC1, CC2, CC3 & CC4 minis (DK, 57 yds ea)

Size J Tunisian crochet hook

Finished Dimensions

approximately 9.5" tall x 16" wide when laying flat
exact gauge is not crucial

Abbreviations

ch - chain

FP - forward pass

RP - reverse pass

YO - yarn over

Notes

As a reminder, one row of Tunisian crochet is worked in two parts: a forward pass and a reverse pass. One row is done when both have been completed. To make a smooth color change at the end of a FP, insert the hook in the last edge stitch, drop current color, and pick up new color to pull a loop through.

Stitch Pattern: Tunisian Simple Stitch

FP: skipping the bar below the loop on hook, insert hook in prominent vertical bar from right to left. YO and pull a loop through, adding one loop to the hook. Repeat this in every single stitch to the end. For the edge stitch, insert the hook through the vertical bar as well as the strand behind it, and pull up a loop. This creates a more stable edge similar to the other side.

RP: YO and pull through one loop. YO and pull through two loops at a time all the way to the end. One loop should remain on the hook.

Pattern

With CC1, ch 115. Pick up sts along the back bumps of ch, including the bump closest to the hook. 116 loops on hook.

Work a RP, then three more Tunisian Simple Stitch rows in CC1 for a total of 4 rows.

Color transition:

Row 1: Work a FP in CC1, then a RP in CC2

Row 2: Work a FP in CC2, then a RP in CC1

Row 3: Work a FP in CC1, then a RP in CC2

Cut CC1

Continue in this pattern, in the following color order:

4 rows of CC2, then transition from CC2 to CC3. Cut CC2

4 rows of CC3, then transition from CC3 to CC4. Cut CC3

4 rows of CC4, then transition from CC4 to MC. Cut CC4.

Work 12 rows in MC.

Slip stitch bind off:

In a FP, pull up a loop until there are 2 on the hook. Pull the new loop through the old loop in a slip stitch. Continue in every stitch across.

Fasten off, block as desired, and seam along the short edges.
