Variable Rate Services

Diagnostic Fee

For instruments experiencing issues with electronic components an initial diagnostic fee will apply. The minimum charge is \$40 and the maximum charge is \$99. For complex issues that require further troubleshooting, an estimate will be sent to the customer for approval before proceeding further.

Hourly Rate

For services not included in the fixed rate list below, a rate of \$99/hr shall apply. There is a minimum shop fee of \$5 for tasks such as changing individual strings, tightening knobs, etc. Service fee excludes cost of parts and consumables.

Amplifiers

Fixed Rate Services

Minimum Shop Charge

There is a minimum shop charge of \$5.

Pre-Appraisal Evaluations

We are not licensed to perform official appraisals on guitars in-store; however, we can do an inspection of the instrument prior to a 3rd party appraisal to spot problem areas or identify work that needs done. The minimum charge for this service is \$15.

Materials

Service rates exclude shop materials, strings, parts, electronics, or other materials required to perform the service.
