## Supplies

$\begin{array}{ll}1 & \begin{array}{l}\text { Bird in a Tree Button } \\ (94-6577-12)\end{array} \\ 10 & 4 \times 2 \mathrm{~mm} \text { ID Barrel Bead } \\ & (94-5791-40) \\ 8 & 5 \mathrm{~mm} \text { Faceted Bead }(93-0451-12) \\ 22 \text { " } & 2 \mathrm{~mm} \text { round cord, black }\end{array}$

## Required Tools

Scissors, flat nose or nylon jawed pliers or hammer and bench block

## Finished Size

6-9 inches

## Instructions

TIP: If using hammer and bench block to secure barrel beads, place an old cloth over bead to minimize hammer marks.

1. Thread cord through button shank.
2. Move button to center, then fold cord in half.
3. String one barrel bead onto both cords followed by one faceted bead onto one cord. Slide beads down near button.
4. Repeat Step 3 seven times, stringing faceted beads on alternate cords each time.
5. String on two barrel beads for button loop.
6. Determine desired bracelet length and placement of button loop then position the two barrel beads accordingly.
7. Secure first barrel bead in place by crimping with flat nose or nylon jawed pliers OR flatten slightly using hammer and bench block.

Check to make sure button will fit through loop then secure second barrel bead.
8. Tie an overhand knot in the end of each cord, positioning knots as close to button loop as desired. (Optional: add drop of adhesive to knot) Trim excess cord.
9. Spread out and arrange beads along bracelet as desired.
10. Optional: If desired, use pliers or hammer to secure barrel beads in place along bracelet.
