



# YARN TWISTERS

Sunshine Shawl  
created by Lisa Overby



Lightweight triangle shaped shawl. Sample is knit with Yarn Twisters July 2020 colourway, Rose Gold.



## MATERIALS & INFO

Yarn: 1 skein Yarn Twisters SW Sock Yarn 380m (415 yards)/100 g; 75% Superwash Merino, 25% Nylon; Sample knit in colourway Rose Gold

Gauge: 28 sts by 22 rows equal 4" by 4" in pattern after blocking

Needles: 3.5 mm (US 4) 32" circular needles, or size needed to obtain gauge

Notions: stitch markers (optional to mark RS of shawl), darning needle

Finished size: Depth at widest point: 21" (53 cm); Length: 68" (173 cm)

## ABBREVIATIONS

**BO** - bind off

**CO** - cast on

**k** - knit

**k2tog** - knit 2 together; insert needle into the next 2 sts, knit the 2 sts together as one (1 st decreased)

**kfb** - knit into the front of the stitch, leaving on the left hand needle, knit into the back of the same stitch, dropping the stitch off the left hand needle (1 stitch increased)

**LHN** - left hand needle

**p** - purl

**RHN** - right hand needle

**RS** - right side

**st/sts** - stitch/stitches

**tbl** - through the back loop

**WS** - wrong side

**yo** - yarnover

## PATTERN INSTRUCTIONS

### Set up

CO 3 sts

**Row 1 (WS):** k

**Row 2 (RS):** k to last 2 sts, kfb, k1 (4 sts)

**Row 3, 4 and 5:** k

Repeat **Rows 2 to 5** five more times (9 sts)

### Main Section

**Row 1 (RS):** k3, (k1, yo, k2tog, k1), repeat to last 2 sts, kfb, k1 (1 st increased)

**Row 2 (WS):** k3, p to last 3 sts, k3

**Row 3:** k3, (yo, k2tog, k2), repeat to last 3 sts, k3

**Row 4:** k3, p to last 3 sts, k3

**Row 5:** k3, (k1, yo, k2tog, k1), repeat to last 3 sts, k1, kfb, k1 (1 st increased)

**Row 6:** k4, p to last 3 sts, k3

**Row 7:** k3, (k2, yo, k2tog), repeat to last 4 sts, k4

**Row 8:** k4, p to last 3 sts, k3

**Row 9:** k3, (k1, yo, k2tog, k1), repeat to last 4 sts, k2, kfb, k1 (1 st increased)

**Row 10:** k5, p to last 3 sts, k3

**Row 11:** k3, (yo, k2tog, k2), repeat to last 5 sts, k5

**Row 12:** k5, p to last 3 sts, k3

**Row 13:** k3, (k1, yo, k2tog, k1), repeat to last 5 sts, k3, kfb, k1 (1 st increased)

**Row 14:** k6, p to last 3 sts, k3

**Row 15:** k3, (k2, yo, k2tog), repeat to last 6 sts, k6

**Row 16:** k6, p to last 3 sts, k3



## PATTERN INSTRUCTIONS cont'd

Repeat **Rows 1 to 16** twenty-one more times (4 sts increased per section repeat, 97 sts)

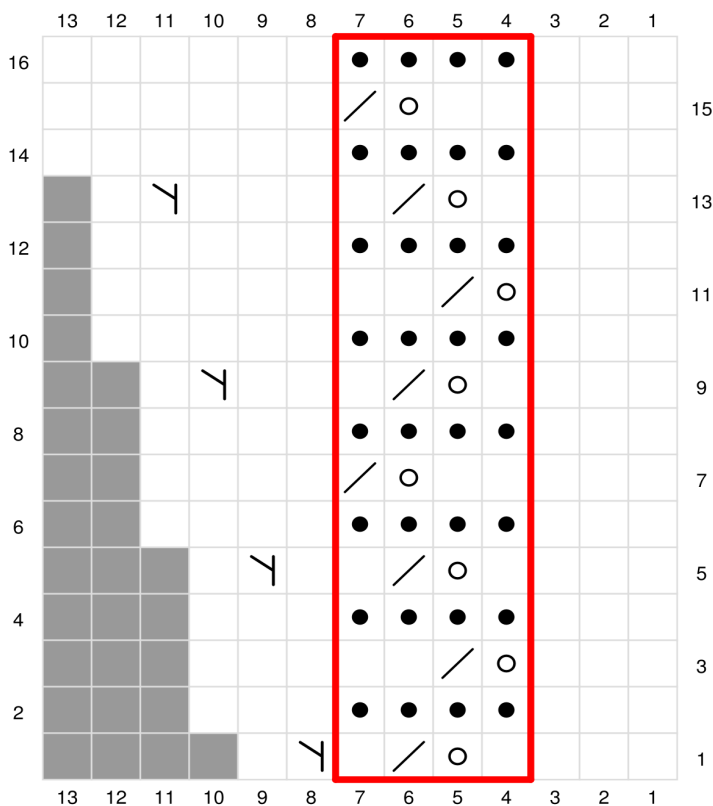
Then repeat **Rows 1 to 8** once more (99 sts)






### I-cord Bind Off

Cable CO 2 sts (see below), \*k2, k2tog tbl, slip 3 sts back to the LHN\*, repeat \*\* until 2 sts remain; slip 3 sts back to the LHN, k2tog, k1, slip 2sts back to LHN, k2tog tbl, break yarn, pull through the remaining st

Weave in ends, block to measurements

**cable CO**- insert needle between the first 2 sts on the left hand needle, you will knit between these stitches (instead of knitting into a stitch), wrap yarn and knit, a new stitch is created, slip new stitch onto left hand needle



-  RS: Knit  
WS: Knit
-  RS: Purl  
WS: Purl
-  Knit 2 together
-  Yarn over
-  No stitch
-  Knit front back
-  repeat
