Oversized triangle shawl is knit with 1 ball of Scheepjes Whirligig, a DK weight yarn that is designed to graduate from one colour to the next. The best part, no ends to weave in from all the colour changes, the magic is in the yarn!

	Yarn: 1 ball Scheepjes Whirligig, 80% Virgin Wool, 20% Alpaca, 1000 m (1094 yards)/450 gram; Sample knit in colourway Grey to Blue	BO - Bind off
		<b>cdd</b> - centre double decrease; slip 2 stitches as if to k2tog, knit 1, pass 2 slipped stitches together over the knit stitch (2 stitches decreased)

# PATTERN INSTRUCTIONS

#### Simple Lace Tab CO

CO 3 sts

Row 1: k1, yo, k2tog

Repeat **Row 1** six more times, rotate piece and pick up 3 sts along the side edge, picking up 1 st for every ridge, pick and k 3 CO sts (9 sts)

**Note:** The first 3 sts and the last 3 sts of every row will be worked as follows to maintain the simple lace edge: **k1, yo, k2tog**; the pattern instructions will not include the edge instructions after **Row 1** in the set up section; the st count given will not include the 6 edge sts

# Set Up

Row 1 RS: k1, yo, k2tog (edge), pm, yo, p1, yo, pm, k1, pm, yo, k1, yo, pm, k1, yo, k2tog (edge) (7 sts) Row 2 (WS): k the k sts and p the p sts and yarnovers Row 3: yo, k1, p1, k1, yo, k1, yo, k1, p1, k1, yo (11 sts) Row 5: yo, k2, p1, k2, yo, k1, yo, k2, p1, k2, yo (15 sts) Row 7: yo, k3, p1, k3, yo, k1, yo, k3, p1, k3, yo (19 sts) Row 9: yo, k4, p1, k4, yo, k1, yo, k4, p1, k4, yo (23 sts) Row 10: as Row 2



# PATTERN INSTRUCTIONS cont'd

### **Main Pattern**

**Row 11:** yo, [p1, k2tog, k2, yo, k1, yo, k2, ssk], repeat to 1 st before marker, p1, yo, sm, k1, sm, yo, [p1, k2tog, k2, yo, k1, yo, k2, ssk], repeat to 1 st before marker, p1, yo (4 sts increased)

Row 12 (WS): k the k sts and p the p sts and yarnovers

**Row 13:** yo, k1, [p1, k2tog, k1, yo, k3, yo, k1, ssk], repeat to 2 sts before, marker, p1, k1, yo, sm, k1, sm, yo, k1, [p1, k2tog, k1, yo, k3, yo, k1, ssk], repeat to 2 sts before marker, p1, k1, yo (4 sts increased)

**Row 15:** yo, k2, [p1, k2tog, yo, k5, yo, ssk], repeat to 3 sts before marker, p1, k2, yo, sm, k1, sm, yo, k2, [p1, k2tog, yo, k5, yo, ssk], repeat to 3 sts before marker, p1, k2, yo (4 sts increased)

**Row 17:** yo, k3, [p1, k2, yo, ssk, k1, k2tog, yo, k2], repeat to 4 sts before, marker, p1, k3, yo, sm, k1, sm, yo, k3, [p1, k2, yo, ssk, k1, k2tog, yo, k2], repeat to 4 sts before marker, p1, k3, yo (4 sts increased)

**Row 19:** yo, k4, [p1, k3, yo, cdd, yo, k3], repeat to 5 sts before marker, p1, k4, yo, sm, k1, sm, yo, k4, [p1, k3, yo, cdd, yo, k3], repeat to 5 sts before marker, p1, k4, yo (4 sts increased)

Row 20: as Row 12

Repeat Rows 11 to 20 seventeen more times (383 sts)

Repeat Rows 11 to 14 one more time (391 sts)

# Reminder: St counts do not include the 6 edge sts

### Finishing

BO all sts using the icord BO as follows:

**Step 1:** Cable CO 3 sts; \*insert RHN between 1st and 2nd st on LHN, wrap working yarn and draw through so that you have a new st on your RHN, place the new st on the LHN; repeat from \* two more times for a total of three new sts

Step 2: k2, k2tog tbl, three sts on the RHN

Step 3: slip these three sts back to the LHN

Repeat **Steps 2 and 3** until all the sts have been worked

Weave in ends and enjoy!
