



YARN TWISTERS

1st Anniversary Shawl

created by Lisa Overby



This textured triangle shawl was designed to celebrate the 1st anniversary of Yarn Twisters opening. The shawl is knit with 3 skeins of DK weight yarn in gradient colours. Sample was knit in Yarn Twisters DK Yarn, colours Grapefruit, Fruit Punch and Cherry.



MATERIALS & INFO

Yarn: 3 skeins Yarn Twisters DK Yarn 246 yards/100 grams, sample knit with colour 1 (C1) Grapefruit, colour 2 (C2) Fruit Punch, colour 3 (C3) Cherry

Gauge: 14 sts by 25 rows in double seed stitch

Needles: 3.75mm (US 5)

Notions: darning needle, 2 stitch markers

Finished size: Wingspan: 193 cm/76"; Centre depth: 88.5 cm/35"

Note: Sample used all of C3 and most of C1 and C2. Recommend swatching with C2, with the possibility of having to frog it to complete your shawl.

ABBREVIATIONS

BO - bind off

CO - cast on

K - knit

MB - make bobble: knit into the front, back, and front of stitch (3 stitches in 1), turn to wrong side, purl 3 stitches, turn to right side, knit 3 stitches, with tip of left hand needle, pull the second and third stitch over the first stitch one at a time. P - purl

PM - place marker

SM - slip marker

st/sts - stitch/stiches

YO - yarn over (1 stitch increased)

PATTERN INSTRUCTIONS

Garner tab Cast on:

With C1, CO on 3 sts

Knit 7 rows, do not turn work. Pick up 3 stitches along edge (1 in each of the garter valleys), pick up 3 stitches from the CO edge. (9 sts)

Set up Rows:

Row 1 (RS): K3, YO, K1, YO, PM, K1, PM, YO, K1, YO, K3 (13 sts)

Row 2: (WS): K3, *K1, P1*, repeat * to * until 4 sts remaining, K4

Double Seed Stitch Section:

Row 1 (RS): K3, YO, *K1, P1*, repeat * to * until 1 st before marker, K1, YO, SM K1, SM, YO, *K1, P1*, repeat * to * until 4 sts remaining, K1, YO, K3 (4 sts increased)

Row 2 (WS): K3, *K1, P1*, repeat * to * until 4 sts remaining, K4

Work **Rows 1 & 2** thirty-three more times, break C1 (149 sts)

Bobble Section #1:

Row 1 with C2 (RS): K3, YO, P to marker, YO, SM, K1, SM, YO, P to 3 sts remaining, YO, K3 (153 sts)

Row 2 and every even (WS) row: K3, P to last 3 sts, K3

Row 3: (RS): K3, YO, K to marker, YO, SM, K1, SM, YO, K to 3 sts remaining, YO, K3 (157 sts)

Row 5: (RS): K3, YO, K to marker, YO, SM, K1, SM, YO, K to 3 sts remaining, YO, K3 (161 sts)

Row 7: (RS): K3, YO, *K5, MB* repeat to 5 sts before marker, K5, YO, SM, K1, SM, YO, *K5, MB*, repeat * to * to 8 sts remaining, K5, YO, K3 (165 sts)



PATTERN INSTRUCTIONS cont'd

Row 9: K3, YO, K to marker, YO, SM, K1, SM, YO, K to 3 sts remaining, YO, K3 (169 sts)

Row 11: K3, YO, K to marker, YO, SM, K1, SM, YO, K to 3 sts remaining, YO, K3 (173 sts)

Row 13: K3, YO, *K5, MB* repeat to 5 sts before marker, K5, YO, SM, K1, SM, YO, *K5, MB*, repeat * to * to 8 sts remaining, K5, YO, K3 (177 sts)

Row 15: K3, YO, K to marker, YO, SM, K1, SM, YO, K to 3 sts remaining, YO, K3 (181 sts)

Row 17: K3, YO, K to marker, YO, SM, K1, SM, YO, K to 3 sts remaining, YO, K3 (185 sts)

Row 19: K3, YO, *K5, MB* repeat to 5 sts before marker, K5, YO, SM, K1, SM, YO, *K5, MB*, repeat * to * to 8 sts remaining, K5, YO, K3 (189 sts)

Row 21: K3, YO, K to marker, YO, SM, K1, SM, YO, K to 3 sts remaining, YO, K3 (193 sts)

Row 23: K3, YO, K to marker, YO, SM, K1, SM, YO, K to 3 sts remaining, YO, K3 (197 sts)

Row 24 (WS): K to marker, SM, P1, SM, K to end

Welt Section:

Row 1 with C1 (RS): K3, YO, K to marker, YO, SM, K1, SM, YO, K to 3 sts remaining, YO, K3 (4 sts increased), do not turn work, slide sts to work RS again

Row 2 with C2 (RS): P3, K to 3 sts remaining, P3, do not turn work, slide sts to work RS again.

Row 3 with C3 (RS): K3, YO, K to marker, YO, SM, K1, SM, YO, K to 3 sts remaining, YO, K3 (4 sts increased), turn work

Row 4 with C1 (WS): K to marker, SM, P1, SM, K to end, do not turn work, slide sts to work WS again

Row 5 with C2: P3, YO, K to marker, YO, SM, P1, SM, YO, K to 3 sts remaining, YO, P3 (4 sts increased), do not turn work, slide sts to work WS again

Row 6 with C3 (WS): K to marker, SM, P1, SM, K to end

Repeat **Rows 1 to 6** six more times (281 sts), break C1 and C2

Bobble Section #2:

Row 1 (RS): K3, YO, K to marker, YO, SM, K1, SM, YO, K to 3 sts remaining, YO, K3 (285 sts)

Row 2 and every even (WS) row: K3, P to last 3 sts, K3

Repeat **Rows 1 & 2** two more times (293 sts)

Row 7: (RS): K3, YO, *K5, MB* repeat to 5 sts before marker, K5, YO, SM, K1, SM, YO, *K5, MB*, repeat * to * to 8 sts remaining, K5, YO, K3 (297 sts)

Row 9: K3, YO, K to marker, YO, SM, K1, SM, YO, K to 3 sts remaining, YO, K3 (301 sts)

Row 11: K3, YO, K to marker, YO, SM, K1, SM, YO, K to 3 sts remaining, YO, K3 (305 sts)

Row 13: K3, YO, *K5, MB* repeat to 5 sts before marker, K5, YO, SM, K1, SM, YO, *K5, MB*, repeat * to * to 8 sts remaining, K5, YO, K3 (309 sts)

Row 15: K3, YO, K to marker, YO, SM, K1, SM, YO, K to 3 sts remaining, YO, K3 (313 sts)

Row 17: K3, YO, K to marker, YO, SM, K1, SM, YO, K to 3 sts remaining, YO, K3 (317 sts)

Row 19: K3, YO, K to marker, YO, SM, K1, SM, YO, K to 3 sts remaining, YO, K3 (321 sts)

Row 20: K to marker, SM, P1, SM, K to end, break C3

Finishing:

Row 1 with C2: K3, YO, K to marker, YO, SM, K1, SM, YO, K to 3 sts remaining, YO, K3 (325 sts)

Row 2: K to marker, SM, P1, SM, K to end

BO all sts using the following stretchy bind off: K 1 st, *K1, insert the left hand needle into the 2 sts on the right hand and K the 2 sts together through the back loop (1 st left on the right needle); repeat from * until you have bound off all sts.

Weave in ends, wet block shawl to measurements.
