

## Andalusian Hat created by Lisa Overby



This hat knits up quick in worsted weight yarn. A simple 4 row repeat makes this hat a great beginner project. The Andalusian stitch creates a nice textured pattern that looks great on everyone.



## **MATERIALS & INFO**

Yarn: Estelle Worsted, 200m (220 yards), 100gr

Gauge: 20sts x 28 rows in Andalusian stitch

Needles: 5mm (US8) 16" circular needles, 5mm (US8)

DPN's

Notions: stitch marker, darning needle

Finished size: 36 cm (14") circumference (unstretched);

26cm (10") long

## **ABBREVIATIONS**

CO - cast on

k - knit

**k2tog** - knit the 2 sts together as one. (1 st de-

creased)

**p** - purl

st/sts - stitch/stiches

## PATTERN INSTRUCTIONS

CO 80 sts, join to knit in the round, careful not to twist.

k2, p2 ribbing for 2"

Rnd 1-3: k all sts

Rnd 4: \*k1, p1\*, repeat \* to \* until end of rnd

Repeat Rnds 1-4 until hat measures approx 20cm (8")

Decrease for the crown, switch to DPN's when sts no longer fits comfortably on 16" circular needle

Rnd 1: \*k8, k2tog\*, repeat \* to \* until end of rnd (72 sts)

Rnd 2: k all sts

**Rnd 3**: \*k7, k2tog\*, repeat \* to \* until end of rnd (64 sts)

Rnd 4: \*k1, p1\*, repeat \* to \* until end of rnd

Rnd 5: \*k6, k2tog\*, repeat \* to \* until end of rnd (56 sts)

Rnd 6: K all sts

Rnd 7: \*k5, k2tog\*, repeat \* to \* until end of rnd (48 sts)

Rnd 8: \*k1, p1\*, repeat \* to \* until end of rnd

Rnd 9: \*k4, k2tog\*, repeat \* to \* until end of rnd (40

sts)

Rnd 10: k all sts

Rnd 11: \*k3, k2tog\*, repeat \* to \* until end of rnd (32 sts)

Rnd 12: \*k1, p1\*, repeat \* to \* until end of rnd

Rnd 13: \*k2, k2tog\*, repeat \* to \* until end of rnd (24 sts)

Rnd 14: k all sts

Rnd 15: \*k1, k2tog\*, repeat \* to \* until end of rnd (16 sts)

Rnd 16: \*k1, p1\*, repeat \* to \* until end of rnd

Rnd 17: k2tog, repeat until end of rnd (8 sts)

Break yarn, thread through remaining 8 sts, pull tight. Weave in ends.
