

## Crossroads Hat created by Lisa Overby



Crossroads is a simple cabled lightweight hat, perfect for the fall weather.

Sample is knit with Yarn Twisters SW DK, colourway Caterpillar, a tonal green with hits of yellow and blue. One skein is enough to make the hat and the Crossroads Fingerless Mitts!



## **MATERIALS & INFO**

Yarn: Yarn Twisters SW DK; 100gr/237 yards; Colourway Caterpillar

Gauge: 22 sts x 32 rows with 4.5 mm (US 7) stockinette in the round, blocked

Needles: 4 mm (US 6) 16" circular; 4.5 mm (US 7) 16" circular; 4.5 mm (US 7) DPN's

Notions: stitch marker, darning needle

Finished size: 10 1/2" (26.5 cm) tall; 14" (35.5 cm) circumference at brim (unstretched)

## **ABBREVIATIONS**

**cdd** - slip 2 stitches as if to k2tog, knit 1, pass 2 slipped stitches together over the knit stitch (2 stitches decreased)

CO - cast on

c2r - slip next st to cable needle, hold in back of work; slip 1 purlwise (with yarn in back), then knit the st from the cable needle

**c2l** - slip the next st to cable needle, hold in front of work; knit next st, slip st purlwise (with yarn in back) from cable needle

k - knit

**k2tog** - knit the 2 sts together as one (1 st decreased)

**st/sts** - stitch/stitches

## PATTERN INSTRUCTIONS

Using the long tail cast on method, CO on 96 stitches on 4 mm (US6) needle

Join to work in the round, careful not to twist your stitches, place a stitch marker to denote the beginning of the round

k2, p2 rib for 16 rnds or until brim measures 2"

Switch to 4.5 mm (US7) needle

Rnd 1: \*k14, c2r\*, repeat \* to \* until end of rnd

**Rnd 2:** k to 1 st before marker, slip st to right hand needle, remove marker, slip st back to left hand needle, replace marker

Rnd 3: \*c2l, k12, c2r\*, repeat \* to \* to end of rnd

Rnd 4 and all other even rows except Rnd 32: k

**Rnd 5:** \*k1, c2l, k10, c2r, k1\*, repeat \* to \* to end of rnd

**Rnd 7:** \*k2, c2l, k8, c2r, k2\*, repeat \* to \* to end of rnd

**Rnd 9:** \*k3, c2l, k6, c2r, k3\*, repeat \* to \* to end of rnd

Rnd 11: \*k4, c2l, k4, c2r, k4\*, repeat \* to \* to end of rnd

**Rnd 13:** \*k5, c2l, k2, c2r, k5\*, repeat \* to \* to end of rnd

**Rnd 15:** \*k6, c2l, c2r, k6\*, repeat \* to \* to end of rnd

**Rnd 17:** \*k7, c2r, k7\*, repeat \* to \* to end of rnd

**Rnd 19:** \*k6, c2r, c2l, k6\*, repeat \* to \* to end of rnd

**Rnd 21:** \*k5, c2r, k2, c2l, k5\*, repeat \* to \* to end of rnd

**Rnd 23:** \*k4, c2r, k4, c2l, k4\*, repeat \* to \* to end of rnd

**Rnd 25:** \*k3, c2r, k6, c2l, k3\*, repeat \* to \* to end of rnd

**Rnd 27:** \*k2, c2r, k8, c2l, k2\*, repeat \* to \* to end of rnd

Rnd 29: \*k1, c2r, k10, c2l, k1\*, repeat \* to \* to end of rnd

Rnd 31: \*c2r, k12, c2l\*, repeat \* to \* to end of rnd

Rnd 32: k to marker, remove marker, k1, replace marker

Repeat Rnds 1 to 18 once more

Begin decreases for crown, switch to DPN's when sts no longer fit comfortably on circular needles:

Rnd 1: \*k6, cdd, k7\*, repeat \* to \* until end of rnd (84 sts)

Rnd 2 and all even rows: k

**Rnd 3:** \*k5, cdd, k6\*, repeat \* to \* to end of rnd (72 sts)

**Rnd 5:** \*k4, cdd, k5\*, repeat \* to \* to end of rnd (60 sts)

**Rnd 7:** \*k3, cdd, k4\*, repeat \* to \* to end of rnd (48 sts)

**Rnd 9:** \*k2, cdd, k3\*, repeat \* to \* to end of rnd (36 sts)

**Rnd 11:** \*k1, cdd, k2\*, repeat \* to \* to end of rnd (24 sts)

**Rnd 13:** \*cdd, k1\*, repeat \* to \* to end of rnd (12 sts)

Rnd 15: k2tog to end of rnd (6 sts)

Cut yarn, thread through remaining 6 sts, pull tight. Weave in ends, and block.
