

# Royal Anne Cherry Shawl created by Lisa Overby



The Royal Anne Cherry is a cherry with a sweet flavor and skin colour that is light yellow with a pinkish blush. This asymmetrical triangle shawl was designed to showcase the beautiful colourway, Sakura-Fubuki, created by Kim from Gingersnap for Yarn Twisters May 2019 monthly yarn.

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MATERIALS & INFO	ABBREVIATIONS
Yarn: Gingersnap Zest Fingering, colourway Sakura- <b>BO</b> - bind off	BO - bind off
Fubuki Gauge: 19 sts by 30 rows in stockinette	<b>cdd</b> - slip 2 stitches as if to K2tog, knit 1, pass 2 slipped stitches together over the knit stitch (2 stitches decreased)
Needles: 3.75mm (US 5)	
Notions: darning needle, 66 6/0 seed beads and small size crochet hook (optional for adding beads to the picot bind off)	<b>cdd (purl)</b> - slip 2 stitches as if to P2tog tbl, purl 1, pass 2 slipped stitches together over the purled stitch (2 stitches decreased)
Finished size: 46" from tip to tip, 14 1/4" at widest point of triangle	CO - cast on
	<b>k</b> - knit
	<b>kfb</b> - knit into the front of the stitch, leaving on the left hand needle, knit into the back of the same stitch, dropping the stitch off the left hand needle (1 stitch increased)
	<b>k2tog</b> - knit the 2 stitches together as one. (1 stitch decreased)
	<b>p</b> - purl
	<b>p2tog</b> - purl the 2 stitches together as one (1 stitch decreased
	<b>p2tog tbl</b> - purl the 2 stitches together as one through the back loop (1 stitch decreased)
	<b>ssk</b> - slip 1 stitch knit wise, slip the next stitch knit wise, insert left needle through the fronts of both slipped stitches, knit the 2 stitches together as on through the back loop (1 stitch decreased)
	<b>yo</b> - yarn over (1 stitch increased)

## PATTERN INSTRUCTIONS

#### CO on 4 sts

#### Set up:

**Row 1** (WS): k1, kfb, k2 (5 sts)

Row 2 (RS): k1, k2tog, kfb, k1 (5 sts)

Row 3 (WS): k1, kfb, p to 2 sts remaining, k2 (6 sts)

### Main Section:

Row 1 (RS): k1, k2tog, k to 2 sts remaining, kfb, k1

Row 2 (WS): k1, kfb, p to 2 sts remaining, k2

Repeat Rows 1 & 2 until there are 103 sts.

### Lace Border:

**Row 1**: k1, k2tog, \*yo, ssk, k3, k2tog, yo, k1\*, repeat \* to \* until 4 sts remaining, k2, kfb, k1 (103 sts)

**Row 2** and all WS rows until **Row 20:** k1, kfb, p to 2 sts remaining, k2 (1 st increased)

**Row 3**: k1, k2tog, yo, ssk, k1, k2tog, yo, k2, \*k1, yo, ssk, k1, k2tog, yo, k2\*, repeat \* to \* until 6 sts remaining, k1, yo, ssk, k1, kfb, k1 (104 sts)

**Row 5:** k1, k2tog, yo, cdd, yo, k3, \*k2, yo, cdd, yo, k3\*, repeat \* to \* until 8 sts remaining, k2, yo, cdd, yo, k1, kfb, k1 (105 sts)

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# PATTERN INSTRUCTIONS cont'd

Row 7: k1, k2tog, k to 2 sts remaining, kfb, k1 (106 sts)

**Row 9**: k1, k2tog, yo, ssk, k2, \*k1, k2tog, yo, k1, yo, ssk, k2\*, repeat \* to \* until 4 sts remaining, k2, kfb, k1 (107 sts)

**Row 11:** k1, k2tog, k3, \*k1, k2tog, yo, k1, yo, ssk, k2\*, repeat \* to \* until 6 sts remaining, k1, k2tog, yo, k1, kfb, k1 (108 sts)

**Row 13:** k1, k2tog, k2, \*yo, ssk, k3, k2tog, yo, k1\*, repeat \* to \* until 8 sts remaining, yo, ssk, k4, kfb, k1 (109 sts)

**Row 15:** k1, k2tog, k1, \*k1, yo, ssk, k1, k2tog, yo, k2\*, repeat \* to \* until 2 sts remaining, kfb, k1 (110 sts)

**Row 17:** k1, k2tog, \*k2, yo, cdd, yo, k3\*, repeat \* to \* until 4 sts remaining, k2, kfb, k1 (111 sts)

**Row 19:** k1, k2tog, k2tog, yo, k1, yo, ssk, k2, \*k1, k2tog, yo, k1, yo, ssk, k2\*, repeat \* to \* until 6 sts remaining, k1, k2tog, yo, k1, kfb, k1 (112 sts)

**Row 21:** k1, k2tog, k2, yo, ssk, k2, \*k1, k2tog, yo, k1, yo, ssk, k2\*, repeat \* to \* until 8 sts remaining, k1, k2tog, yo, k1, yo, ssk, kfb, k1 (113 sts)

**Row 22**: k1, kfb, p4, p2tog tbl, yo, p1, \*yo, p2tog, p3, p2tog tbl, yo, p1\*, repeat \* to \* until 8 sts remaining, yo, p2tog, p4, k2 (114 sts)

**Row 23:** k1, k2tog, k1, k2tog, yo, k2, \*k1, yo, ssk, k1, k2tog, yo, k2\*, repeat \* to \* until 2 sts remaining, kfb, k1 (114 sts)

Row 24: k1, kfb, p1, \*p1, yo, p2tog, yo, cdd purl, yo, p2tog tbl, yo\*, repeat \* to \* until 7 sts remaining, p1, yo, p2tog, p2, k2 (115 sts)

**Row 25:** k1, k2tog, yo, k2tog, k2, \*k1, ssk, yo, k1, yo, k2tog, k2\*, repeat \* to \* until 4 sts remaining, k2, kfb, k1 (115 sts)

Row 26: k1, kfb, yo, p2tog tbl, p1, \*p2, p2tog, yo, p1, yo, p2tog tbl, p1\*, repeat \* to \* until 6 sts remaining, p2, p2tog, yo, k2 (116 sts)

**Row 27:** k1, k2tog, k3, \*k1, yo, ssk, k1, k2tog, yo, k2\*, repeat \* to \* until 6 sts remaining, k1, yo, ssk, k1, kfb, k1 (116 sts)

**Row 28:** k1, kfb, yo, cdd purl, yo, p2tog tbl, yo, \*p1, yo, p2tog, yo, cdd purl, yo, p2tog tbl, yo\*, repeat \* to until 5 sts remaining, p1, yo, p2tog, k2 (117 sts)

**Row 29:** k1, k2tog, k2, \* k1, ssk, yo, k1, yo, k2tog, k2\*, repeat \* to \* until 8 sts remaining, k1, ssk, yo, k1, yo, k2tog, kfb, k1 (117 sts)

**Row 30:** k1, kfb, p1, p2tog, y0, p1, y0, p2tog tbl, p1, \*p2, p2tog, y0, p1, y0, p2tog tbl, p1\*, repeat \* to \* until 4 sts remaining, p2, k2 (118 sts)

Lace section is complete, continue repeating **Rows 1** & 2 of the main section until you have 130 sts, repeat **Row 1** (RS) once more.

## Set up for bind off:

(WS) k1, kfb, \*p1, k1\*, repeat \* to \* to end of row

## Picot bind off with beads:

Using the cable CO, \*CO 2 sts to the left hand needle, k2tog tbl, bead the next stitch using preferred beading method, k the beaded st, pass the 1st st over the 2nd st (k2tog tbl over the beaded st), BO 2 sts, place st back on left hand needle\*

Repeat \* to \* until all sts have been bound off. Weave in ends and block shawl.


# Alternative Bind off:

Picot bind off with no beads:

Using the cable CO, \*CO 2 sts to the left hand needle, BO 4 sts, slip st back to left hand needle\*

Repeat \* to \* until all sts are bound off

Weave in ends, block to measurements.



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
