



YARN TWISTERS

Chevron Toque
created by Lisa Overby



Simple Chevron pattern makes for a quick but interesting knit!



MATERIALS & INFO

Yarn: Shirley Brian, Tumnus Tweed Worsted, 85% Superwash Merino, 15% Donegal Nep, 182 yards/100 grams, sample knit in Pardon my Pinot

Gauge: 20sts x 28 rows in Chevron Pattern

Needles: 5mm (US8) 16" circular needles, 5mm (US8) DPN's

Notions: stitch markers, darning needle

Finished size: 14" circumference (ribbing); 17" circumference (body) (unstretched), 9" tall

Note: Toque will fit an average ladies head, to change the size, increase or decrease the number of sts by 18 to maintain chevron pattern

ABBREVIATIONS

CO - cast on

DPN - double pointed needle

k - knit

k2tog - knit 2 together; insert needle into the next 2 sts, knit the 2 sts together as one (1 st decreased)

p - purl

Rnd - round

ssk - slip, slip, knit; slip 2 sts knit wise, one at a time, to the right hand needle, place sts back on left hand needle and knit them together through their back loops (1 st decreased)

st/sts - stitch/stitches

tbl - through the back loop

PATTERN INSTRUCTIONS, Chart on Page 3

CO 90 sts, join to knit in the round, careful not to twist your sts, place a st marker to denote the beginning of the rnd

k1tbl, p1 ribbing for 2"

Note: It is helpful to place a st marker every 18 sts when working the chevron pattern

Rnd 1: *p1, k2, p2, k2, p2, k1, p2, k2, p2, k2*, repeat to end of rnd

Rnd 2: *p2, k2, p2, k2, p3, k2, p2, k2, p1*, repeat to end of rnd

Rnd 3: *p3, k2, p2, k5, p2, k2, p2*, repeat to end of rnd

Rnd 4: *p1, k1, p2, k2, p2, k3, p2, k2, p2, k1*, repeat to end of rnd

Repeat **Rnds 1-4** ten more times, hat will measure approximately 8" from CO edge

Decrease for the crown, switch to DPN's when sts no longer fits comfortably on 16" circular needle

Rnd 1: *p1, k2tog, p2, k2, p2, k1, p2, k2, p2, ssk*, repeat to end of the rnd (80 sts)

Rnd 2: *p1, k2tog, p2, k2, p3, k2, p2, ssk*, repeat to end of the rnd (70 sts)

Rnd 3: *p1, k2tog, p2, k5, p2, ssk*, repeat to end of the rnd (60 sts)

Rnd 4: *p1, k2tog, p2, k3, p2, ssk*, repeat to end of the rnd (50 sts)

Rnd 5: *p1, k2tog, p2, k1, p2, ssk*, repeat to end of the rnd (40 sts)

Rnd 6: *p1, k2tog, p3, ssk*, repeat to end of the rnd (30 sts)

Rnd 7: *p1, k2tog, k1, ssk*, repeat to end of the rnd (20 sts)

Rnd 8: *k2tog, ssk*, repeat to end of the rnd (10 sts)

Break yarn, thread through remaining 10 sts, pull tight, weave in ends; sample toque was not blocked
