



# YARN TWISTERS

## 2nd Anniversary Shawl created by Lisa Overby



Using 2 skeins of Sweet Georgia Superwash DK to create this simple, cozy boomerang shawl. This shawl was created to celebrate Yarn Twisters 2nd anniversary celebration.



## MATERIALS & INFO

Yarn: 2 skeins Sweet Georgia Superwash DK 234m (256 yards)/115 g; 100% Superwash Merino; Sample knit in C1 - Mango Ice, C2 - Sapphire

Gauge: 18 sts by 34 rows equal 4" by 4" in garter before blocking; 15 sts by 30 rows equal 4" by 4" in garter after blocking

Needles: 4.5 mm (US 7) 32" circular needles, or size needed to obtain gauge

Notions: stitch markers (optional to mark RS of shawl), darning needle

Finished size: Centre Depth: 16.5" (41.5 cm); Wingspan: 69" (175 cm)

## ABBREVIATIONS

**BO** - bind off

**cable CO**- insert needle between the first 2 sts on the left hand needle, you will knit between these stitches (instead of knitting into a stitch), wrap yarn and knit, a new stitch is created. Slip new stitch onto left hand needle.

**CO** - cast on

**k** - knit

**k2tog** - knit 2 together; insert needle into the next 2 sts, knit the 2 sts together as one (1 st decreased)

**kfb** - knit into the front of the stitch, leaving on the left hand needle, knit into the back of the same stitch, dropping the stitch off the left hand needle (1 stitch increased)

**LHN** - left hand needle

**p** - purl

**RHN** - right hand needle

**RS** - right side

**st/sts** - stitch/stitches

**WS** - wrong side

**yo** - yarnover

## PATTERN INSTRUCTIONS

### Set up

With C1, CO 3 sts

**Row 1:** kfb, k2 (4 sts)

**Row 2 :** k2, kfb, k1 (5 sts)

**Row 3:** k1, k2tog, kfb, k1

**Row 4:** kfb, k to end (6 sts)

### Main Body

**Row 1 (RS):** k1, k2tog, k to last 2 sts, kfb, k1

**Row 2 (WS):** kfb, k to end (7 sts)

**Rows 3 to 52,** repeat **Rows 1 and 2** twenty-five more times (32 sts)

Join C2, carry C1 up the side

**Row 53:** k1, k2tog, k to last 2 sts, kfb, k1

**Row 54:** kfb, p to last 3 sts, k3 (33 sts)

**Row 55:** k1, k2tog, (yo, k2, pass yo over last 2 sts knit), repeat to last 2 sts, kfb, k1

**Row 56:** kfb, p to last 3 sts, k3 (34 sts), cut C2

**Rows 57 to 96 with C1,** repeat **Rows 1 and 2** twenty more times (54 sts)



## **PATTERN INSTRUCTIONS cont'd**

Join C2, carry C1 up the side

**Row 97:** k1, k2tog, k to last 2 sts, kfb, k1

**Row 98:** kfb, p to last 3 sts, k3 (55 sts)

**Row 99:** k1, k2tog, (yo, k2, pass YO over last 2 sts knit), repeat to last 2 sts, kfb, k1

**Row 100:** kfb, p to last 3 sts, k3 (56 sts)

**Row 101 with C1:** k1, k2tog, k to last 2 sts, kfb, k1

**Row 102:** kfb, k to end (57 sts)

**Rows 103 and 104,** repeat **Rows 101 and 102** (58 sts)

**Rows 105 to 108 with C2,** repeat **Rows 97 to 100** (60 sts), cut C2

**Rows 109 to 128 with C1,** repeat **Rows 1 and 2** ten times (70 sts)

**Row 129 with C2:** k1, k2tog, k to last 2 sts, kfb, k1

**Row 130:** kfb, k to end, (71 sts), carry C2

**Row 131 to 140 with C1,** repeat **Rows 1 and 2** five times (76 sts)

**Rows 141 and 142 with C2,** repeat **Rows 129 and 130** (77 sts), cut C2

**Rows 143 to 172 with C1,** repeat **Rows 1 and 2** fifteen times (92 sts)

**Row 173 to 176 with C2,** repeat **Rows 129 and 130** two times (94 sts)

**Rows 177 and 178 with C1,** repeat **Rows 1 and 2** one time (95 sts), cut C1

**Row 179 with C2:** k1, k2tog, k to last 2 sts, kfb, k1

**Row 180:** kfb, k to end (96 sts)

**Row 181:** k1, k2tog, k to last 2 sts, kfb, k1

**Row 182:** k1, kfb, p to last 3 sts, k3 (97 sts)

**Row 183:** k1, k2tog, (yo, k2, pass yo over the last 2 sts knit), repeat to last 2 sts, kfb, k1

**Row 184:** kfb, p to last 3 sts, k3 (98 sts)

**Row 185:** k1, k2tog, k to last 2 sts, kfb, k1

**Row 186:** kfb, k to end (99 sts)

**Row 187:** k1, k2tog, k to last 2 sts, kfb, k1

**Row 188:** kfb, p to last 3 sts, k3 (100 sts)

**Row 189:** k1, k2tog, k1, (yo, k2, pass yo over the last 2 sts knit), repeat to last 2 sts, kfb, k1

**Row 190:** kfb, p to last 3 sts, k3 (101 sts)

**Rows 191 to 202,** repeat **Rows 179 to 190** once more (107 sts)

**Row 203 with C1:** k1, k2tog, k to last 2 sts, kfb, k1

**Row 204:** kfb, k to end (108 sts), cut C1

**Rows 205 to 214 with C2,** repeat **Rows 181 to 190** once (113 sts)

**Rows 215 to 238,** repeat **Rows 179 to 190** two times (125 sts)

**Rows 239 with C1:** k1, k2tog, k to last 2 sts, kfb, k1

**Row 240:** kfb, k to end (126 sts), cut C1

**Rows 241 with C2:** k1, k2tog, k to last 2 sts, kfb, k1

**Row 242:** kfb, p to last 3 sts, k3 (127 sts)

**Row 243:** k2tog, (yo, k2, pass yo over the last 2 sts knit), repeat to last 2 sts, kfb, k1

**Row 244:** kfb, p to last 3 sts, k3 (128 sts)

**Row 245:** k1, k2tog, k to last 2 sts, kfb, k1

**Row 246:** kfb, k to end (129 sts), cut C2

### ***Picot Bind off with C1***

Cable CO 2 sts, BO the next 4 sts, slip the one st on the RHN to the LHN purlwise, cable CO 2 sts, BO the next 4 sts, repeat until no sts remain

Weave in ends, block to measurements
