



# YARN TWISTERS

## Bee Content

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Asymmetrical triangle shawl knit with 2 skeins of fingering weight yarn. This shawl is a mixture of stockinette, garter, lace and some fun bobbles. This shawl would look great with a variegated, tonal or solid yarn. The shawl is named after the first lace section, which looks like bees!



## MATERIALS & INFO

Yarn: 2 skeins fingering weight yarn:

Colour 1 (C1): Hedgehog Fibres Sock Yarn;  
437yds/100g; 90% Merino wool, 10% Nylon; colourway  
Potluck (approx 382 yds required)

Colour 2 (C2): Vivid Yarn Studio Signature Fingering;  
463 yds/100g; 75% Superwash Merino, 25% Nylon:  
colourway Bronze (approx 305 yds required)

Gauge: 19 sts by 33 rows equal 4" by 4" in stocki-  
nette after blocking

Needles: 3.75 mm (US 5) 32" circular needles, or size  
needed to obtain gauge

Notions: stitch markers (optional to denote the RS  
and for lace sections), darning needle

Finished size: Centre Depth: 21"(54cm); Wingspan:  
83" (211cm)

## ABBREVIATIONS

**BO** - bind off

**cdd** - slip 2 stitches as if to k2tog, knit 1, pass 2 slipped  
stitches together over the knit stitch (2 stitches de-  
creased)

**CO** - cast on

**k** - knit

**k2tog** - knit 2 together; insert needle into the next 2  
sts, knit the 2 sts together as one (1 st decreased)

**kfb** - knit into the front of the stitch, leaving on the  
left hand needle, knit into the back of the same stitch,  
dropping the stitch off the left hand needle (1 stitch  
increased)

**kfbf** - knit into the front of the stitch, leaving on the  
left hand needle, knit into the back of the same stitch,  
leaving on the left hand needle, knit into the front of  
the same stitch again, dropping the stitch off the left  
hand needle, (2 sts increased)

**LHN** - left hand needle

**MB** - make bobble; kfbf into st (increase from 1 st to 3  
sts), turn work, p across, turn work, k across, turn  
work, p across, turn work, k across, lift 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> sts  
over 1<sup>st</sup> st as if to bind off (decrease from 3 sts to 1 st),  
pull yarn tight on next st to make the bobble neat

**p** - purl

**RHN** - right hand needle

**RS** - right side

**ssk** - slip, slip, knit: slip 2 sts knit wise, one at a time,  
to the right hand needle, place sts back on left hand  
needle and knit them together through their back  
loops (1 st decreased)

**st/sts** - stitch/stitches

**WS** - wrong side

**yo** - yarnover



## PATTERN INSTRUCTIONS

With C1, CO 3 sts

### Setup

Row 1: k1, kfb, k1 (4 sts)

Row 2: k2, kfb, k1 (5sts)

Row 3: k1, kfb, k3 (6 sts)

Row 4: k4, kfb, k1 (7 sts)

Row 5: k1, kfb, p2, k3 (8 sts)

Row 6: k2, k2tog, k2, kfb, k1 (8 sts)

Row 7: k1, kfb, p3, k3 (9 sts)

### Section 1 with C1

Row 1 (RS): k2, k2tog, k to last 2 sts, kfb, k1

Row 2 (WS): k1, kfb, p to last 3 sts, k3 (1 st increased)

**Rows 3 to 82:** repeat **Rows 1 and 2** forty (40) more times (50 sts)

### Section 2 with C1 and C2

Row 1 with C2 (RS): k2, k2tog, k to last 2 sts, kfb, k1

Row 2 (WS): k1, kfb, k to end (1 st increased)

Row 3 with C1: k2, k2tog, k to last 2 sts, kfb, k1

Row 4: k1, kfb, p to last 3 sts, k3 (1 st increased)

**Rows 5 to 60:** repeat **Rows 1 to 4** fourteen (14) more times, cut C1 (80 sts)

### Section 3 with C2

Row 1 (RS): k2, k2tog, k to last 2 sts, kfb, k1

Row 2 and all WS rows: k1, kfb, p to last 3 sts, k3 (1 st increased)

Row 3: as Row 1

Row 5: as Row 1

Row 7: k2, ktog, \*k3, yo, ssk, k1, k2tog, yo, k2\*, repeat \*\* to last 9 sts, k3, yo, ssk, k2, kfb, k1

Row 9: k2, k2tog, k3, yo, cdd, yo, k3, \*k4, yo, cdd, yo, k3\*, repeat \*\* to last 11 sts, k4, yo, cdd, yo, k2, kfb, k1

Row 11: k2, k2tog, k3, MB, k4, \*k5, MB, K4\*, repeat \*\* to last 3 sts, k1, kfb, k1

Row 13: as Row 1

Row 15: as Row 1

Row 17: k2, k2tog, \*k3, yo, ssk, k1, k2tog, yo, k2\*, repeat \*\* to last 4 sts, k2, kfb, k1

Row 19: k2, k2tog, k3, yo, cdd, yo, k3, \*k4, yo, cdd, yo, k3\*, repeat \*\* to last 6 sts, k4, kfb, k1

Row 21: k2, k2tog, k3, MB, k4, \*k5, MB, k4\*, repeat \*\* to last 8 sts, k6, kfb, k1

Row 23: as Row 1

Row 25: as Row 1

Row 26: as Row 2

**Rows 27 to 56:** repeat **Rows 7 to 26** once (1), then **Rows 7 to 16** once (1) (108 sts)

### Section 4 with C1 and C2

Row 1 with C1 (RS): k2, k2tog, k to last 2 sts, kfb, k1

Row 2 (WS): k1, kfb, k to end (1 st increased)

Row 3 with C2: k2, k2tog, k to last 2 sts, kfb, k1

Row 4: k1, kfb, p to last 3 sts, k3 (1 st increased)

**Rows 5 to 60:** repeat **Rows 1 to 4** fourteen (14) more times, cut C2 (138 sts)

### Section 5 with C1 and C2

Row 1 with C1 (RS): k2, k2tog, k to last 2 sts, kfb, k1

Row 2 and all WS Rows: k1, kfb, p to last 3 sts, k3 (1 st increased)

Row 3: as Row 1

Row 5: as Row 1

Row 7: k2, k2tog, \*k3, yo, ssk, k1, k2tog, yo, k2\*, repeat \*\* to last 7 sts, k3, yo, ssk, kfb, k1

Row 9: k2, k2tog, k3, yo, cdd, yo, k3, \*k4, yo, cdd, yo, k3\*, repeat \*\* to last 9 sts, k4, yo, cdd, yo, kfb, k1

Row 11: as Row 1

Row 13: as Row 1

Row 15: as Row 1

Row 17: k2, k2tog, \*k3, yo, ssk, k1, k2tog, yo, k2\*, repeat \*\* to last 2 sts, kfb, k1



## **PATTERN INSTRUCTIONS cont'd**

Row 19: k2, k2tog, k3, yo, cdd, yo, k3, \*k4, yo, cdd, yo, k3\*, repeat \*\* to last 4 sts, k2, kfb, k1

Row 21: as Row 1

Row 23: as Row 1

Row 25: as Row 1

Rows 27 to 36: repeat **Rows 7 to 16**, cut C1 (156 sts)

Row 37 with C2: k2, k2tog, k to last 2 sts, kfb, k1

Row 38: k1, kfb, k to end (1 st increased)

**Rows 39 to 46:** repeat **Rows 37 and 38** four (4) more times, cut C2 (161 sts)

**Rows 47 to 52:** repeat **Rows 1 to 6** (164 sts)

Row 53: k2, k2tog, \*k4, yo, cdd, yo, k3\*, repeat \*\* to last 10 sts, k4, yo, cdd, yo, k1, kfb, k1

Row 55: k2, k2tog, k2, yo, k2tog, k1, ssk, yo, k2, \*k3, yo, k2tog, k1, ssk, yo, k2\*, repeat \*\* to last 2 sts, kfb, k1

Row 57: as Row 1

Row 59: as Row 1

Row 61: as Row 1

Row 63: k2, k2tog, \*k4, yo, cdd, yo, k3\*, repeat \*\* to last 5 sts, k3, kfb, k1

Row 65: k2, k2tog, k2, yo, k2tog, k1, ssk, yo, k2, \*k3, yo, k2tog, k1, ssk, yo, k2\*, repeat \*\* to last 7 sts, k5, kfb, k1

Row 67: as Row 1

Row 69: as Row 1

Row 71: as Row 1

**Row 73 to 82:** repeat **Rows 53 to 62** (179 sts)

### **Section 6 with C1 and C2**

Row 1 with C2 (RS): k2, k2tog, k to last 2 sts, kfb, k1

Row 2 (WS): k1, kfb, k to end (1 st increased)

Row 3 with C1: k2, k2tog, k to last 2 sts, kfb, k1

Row 4: k1, kfb, p to last 3 sts, k3 (1 st increased)

**Rows 5 to 18:** repeat **Rows 1 to 4** three (3) more times, then **Rows 1 and 2** once (1), cut C1 (188 sts)

### **Bind Off with C2**

BO all sts in the following manner to ensure a stretchy edge: k1, \*k1, insert LHN into the 2 sts on the RHN, knit the 2 sts together through the back loop, repeat from \* until all sts have been bound off

Weave in ends, block to measurements.
