Easy learn to knit pattern. Once complete you will have learned how to cast on, the knit stitch, the purl stitch, one row buttonhole, and to cast off.

MATERIALS & INFO

Yarn: 1 ball Drop Andes 90m (98 yards)

Notions: darning needle, two 7/8"buttons

Needles: 9mm (US 13) needles

Finished size: 53cm x 20cm

Gauge: 10 sts x 14 rows equals 4" by 4" in stockinette

ABBREVIATIONS

BO - bind off

CO - cast on

k - knit

k2tog - knit the 2 sts together as one (1 st decreased)

p - purl

st/sts - stitch/stitches

yo - yarnover (1 st increased), bring yarn in front of work, bring yarn over the right hand needle

PATTERN INSTRUCTIONS

Using the long tail cast on method, CO 21 sts		Row	Row	Row	Row	Row
Knit 10 rows		1	2	3	4	5
Begin basket weave pattern:	Repeat 1					
Row 1: k8, p5, k8	Repeat 2					
Row 2: k3, p5, k5, p5, k3	Repeat 3					
Row 3: as Row 1	Repeat 4					
Row 4: as Row 2	Repeat 5					
Row 5: as Row 1	Repeat 6					
Repeat Rows 1 to 5 thirteen more times	Repeat 7					
Knit 5 rows	Repeat 8					
Button hole row - k6, yo, k2tog, k5, k2tog, yo,k6	Repeat 9					
Knit 4 rows	Repeat 10					
Loosely BO all sts, cut yarn, weave in ends	Repeat 11					
Sew buttons on the CO end of cowl to align with but- tonholes	Repeat 12					
Wear and enjoy!	Repeat 13
