



YARN TWISTERS

Simple Ribbed Hat created by Lisa Overby



A simple ribbed hat topped off with a big fluffy pom pom, perfect for the transition from summer to fall. Sample is knit with Tweed Sock from Yarn Ink in a stunning fall colourway dyed for Yarn Twisters October Yarn Kit.



MATERIALS & INFO

Yarn: 1 skein Yarn Ink Tweed Sock, 100gr (400 m/438 yards)

Gauge: 28 sts by 48 rows in 2x2 rib in the round, blocked

Needles: 3mm (US 2.5) 16" circular needle and 3mm (US 2.5) DPN's (or size to obtain gauge as indicated)

Notions: stitch marker, darning needle, pom pom

Finished size: 17.5" (44 cm) circumference; 10 3/4" (27 cm) tall

ABBREVIATIONS

CO - cast on

k - knit

k2tog - knit the 2 sts together as one (1 st decreased)

p - purl

PM - place maker

SM - slip marker

ssk - slip 1 stitch knit wise, slip the next stitch knit wise, insert left needle through the fronts of both slipped stitches, knit the 2 stitches together as on through the back loop (1 stitch decreased)

st/sts - stitch/stitches

PATTERN INSTRUCTIONS

Using the long tail cast on method, CO on 136 stitches on 3 mm (US 2.5) needle

Join to work in the round, careful not to twist your stitches, place a stitch marker to denote the beginning of the round

k2, p2 rib for 10"

Begin decreases for the crown, switch to DPN's when sts no longer fit comfortably on the circular needles:

Rnd 1: *k2, p2tog, k2, p2*, repeat * to * until end of rnd (119 sts)

Rnd 2: work all sts as they appear (knit the knits, purl the purls)

Rnd 3: *k2, p1, k2, p2tog*, repeat * to * until end of rnd (102 sts)

Rnd 4: as Rnd 2

Rnd 5: *k2tog, p1, k2, p1*, repeat * to * until end of rnd (85 sts)

Rnd 6: as Rnd 2

Rnd 7: *k1, p1, k2tog, p1*, repeat * to * until end of rnd (68 sts)

Rnd 8: as Rnd 2

Rnd 9: k2tog to end of rnd (34 sts)

Rnd 10: k2tog to end of rnd (17 sts)

Break yarn, leaving a 6" tail, thread through remaining sts pull tight to close hole

Weave in ends, block to measurement

Sew pom pom to top of hat
