



YARN TWISTERS

London Fog
created by Lisa Overby



This asymmetrical triangle shawl starts at a single point and grows with increases on the one side every other row. The lace section is interesting to knit, the honeycomb brioche adds a nice squish factor and the i-cord edges and bind off make the edges neat. This shawl is knit with 4 skeins of worsted weight yarn. For the sample I used Lily & Pine's Aspen Worsted in the colourway London Fog.



MATERIALS & INFO

Yarn: 4 skeins Lily & Pine Aspen Worsted 210 yards/115 g; 100% SW Merino; Sample knit in colour-way London Fog

Gauge: 24 sts by 22 rows equals 4" by 4" in lace pattern after blocking

Needles: 5.5 mm (US 9) 32" circular needles, or size needed to obtain gauge

Notions: stitch markers, darning needle

Finished size: Centre Depth: 49" (124cm); Wingspan: 62" (157cm)

Notes:

Try to work your i-cord edge sts loosely to avoid a border that is too tight

Stitch markers are helpful through out the lace section of the shawl

Increases are made every WS row

Do not count your sts in the lace section until after completion of the WS row

ABBREVIATIONS

BO - bind off

brk - brioche knit: knit the slipped st and its "yarnover shawl" together as one st

CO - cast on

k - knit

kfb - knit into the front of the stitch, leaving on the left hand needle, knit into the back of the same stitch, dropping the stitch off the left hand needle (1 stitch increased)

k2tog - knit 2 together; insert needle into the next 2 sts, knit the 3 sts together as one (1 st decreased)

k3tog - knit 3 together; insert needle into the next 3 sts, knit the 3 sts together as one (2 sts decreased)

LHN - left hand needle

p - purl

pm - place marker

RHN - right hand needle

RS - right side

sl - slip st purlwise

sl1kw, k2tog, pss0 - slip 1 st knitwise, knit the next 2 sts together, pass slipped st over the k2tog (2 sts decreased)

sl1yo - bring yarn to front of work (if it is not already there), slip st purlwise, wrap a yarnover around the slipped st

st/sts - stitch/stitches

tbl - through the back loop

WS - wrong side

wyif - with yarn in front

yo - yarnover

CO 6 sts, p2, kfb, sl 3 wyif (7 sts)

Set up

Row 1 (RS): k₃, k_{1tbl}, sl₃ wyif

Row 2 (WS): k₂, kfb, p_{1tbl}, sl₃ wyif (8 sts)

Row 3: k₃, p_{1tbl}, k, sl₃ wyif

Row 4: k₂, kfb, k₁, p_{1tbl}, sl₃ wyif (9 sts)

Row 5: k₃, k_{1tbl}, p₂, sl₃ wyif

Row 6: k₂, kfb, k₂, p_{1tbl}, sl₃ wyif (10 sts)

Row 7: k₃, k_{1tbl}, p₂, k₁, sl₃ wyif

Row 8: k₂, kfb, p₁, k₂, p_{1tbl}, sl₃ wyif (11 sts)

Row 9: k₃, k_{1tbl}, p₂, k₂, sl₃ wyif

Row 10: k₂, kfb, p₂, k₂, p_{1tbl}, sl₃ wyif (12 sts)

Row 11: k₃, k_{1tbl}, p₂, k₃, sl₃ wyif

Row 12: k₂, kfb, p₃, k₂, p_{1tbl}, sl₃ wyif (13 sts)

Row 13: k₃, k_{1tbl}, p₂, k_{3tog}, yo, p₁, sl₃ wyif

Row 14: k₂, kfb, k₁, p₁, yo, p₁, k₂, p_{1tbl}, sl₃ wyif (14 sts)

Row 15: k₃, k_{1tbl}, p₂, k₃, p₂, sl₃ wyif

Row 16: k₂, kfb, k₂, p₃, k₂, p_{1tbl}, sl₃ wyif (15 sts)

Row 17: k₃, k_{1tbl}, p₂, yo, sl_{1kw}, k_{2tog}, p_{ssso}, p₂, k_{1tbl}, sl₃ wyif

Row 18: k₂, kfb, p_{1tbl}, k₂ p₁, yo, p₁, k₂, p_{1tbl}, sl₃ wyif (16 sts)

Row 19: k₃, k_{1tbl}, p₂, k₃, p₂, k_{1tbl}, p₁, sl₃ wyif

Row 20: k₂, kfb, k₁, p_{1tbl}, k₂, p₃, k₂, p_{1tbl}, sl₃ wyif (17 sts)

Row 21: k₃, k_{1tbl}, p₂, k_{3tog}, yo, p₂, k_{1tbl}, p₂, sl₃ wyif

Row 22: k₂, kfb, k₂, p_{1tbl}, k₂, p₁, yo, p₁, k₂, p_{1tbl}, sl₃ wyif (18 sts)

Row 23: k₃, k_{1tbl}, p₂, k₃, p₂, k_{1tbl}, p₂, k₁, sl₃ wyif

Row 24: k₂, kfb, p₁, k₂, p_{1tbl}, k₂, p₃, k₂, p_{1tbl}, sl₃ wyif (19 sts)

Row 25: k₃, k_{1tbl}, p₂, yo, sl_{1kw}, k_{2tog}, p_{ssso}, p₂, k_{1tbl}, p₂, k₂, sl₃ wyif

Row 26: k₂, kfb, p₂, k₂, p_{1tbl}, k₂, p₁, yo, p₁, k₂, p_{1tbl}, sl₃ wyif (20 sts)

Row 27: k₃, k_{1tbl}, p₂, k₃, p₂, k_{1tbl}, p₂, k₃, sl₃ wyif

Row 28: k₂, kfb, p₃, k₂, p_{1tbl}, k₂, p₃, k₂, p_{1tbl}, sl₃ wyif (21 sts)

Row 29: k₃, k_{1tbl}, p₂, k_{3tog}, yo, p₂, k_{1tbl}, p₂, k_{3tog}, yo, p₁, sl₃ wyif

Row 30: k₂, kfb, k₁, p₁, yo, p₁, k₂, p_{1tbl}, k₂, p₁, yo, p₁, k₂, p_{1tbl}, sl₃ wyif (22 sts)

Row 31: k₃, *k_{1tbl}, p₂, k₃, p₂*, repeat ** to last 3 sts, sl₃ wyif

Row 32: k₂, kfb, *k₂, p₃, k₂, p_{1tbl}*, repeat ** to last 3 sts, sl₃ wyif (23 sts)

Row 1 (RS): k₃, * k_{1tbl}, p₂, yo, sl_{1kw}, k_{2tog}, p_{ssso}, p₂*, repeat ** to last 4 sts, k_{1tbl}, sl_{3wyif}

Row 2 (WS): k₂, kfb, p_{1tbl}, *k₂, p₁, yo, p₁, k₂, p_{1tbl}*, repeat ** to last 3 sts, sl₃ wyif (1 st increased)

Row 3: k₃, *k_{1tbl}, p₂, k₃, p₂*, repeat ** to last 5 sts, k_{1tbl}, p₁, sl₃ wyif

Row 4: k₂, kfb, k₁, p_{1tbl}, *k₂, p₃, k₂, p_{1tbl}*, repeat ** to last 3 sts, sl_{3wyif} (1 st increased)

Row 5: k₃, * k_{1tbl}, p₂, k_{3tog}, yo, p₂*, repeat ** to last 6 sts, k_{1tbl}, p₂, sl₃ wyif

Row 6: k₂, kfb, k₂, p_{1tbl}, *k₂, p₁, yo, p₁, k₂, p_{1tbl}*, repeat ** to last 3 sts, sl₃ wyif (1 st increased)

Row 7: k₃, *k_{1tbl}, p₂, k₃, p₂*, repeat ** to last 7 sts, k_{1tbl}, p₂, k₁, sl₃ wyif

Row 8: k₂, kfb, p₁, k₂, p_{1tbl}, *k₂, p₃, k₂, p_{1tbl}*, repeat ** to last 3 sts, sl₃ wyif (1 st increased)

Row 9: k₃, *k_{1tbl}, p₂, yo, sl_{1kw}, k_{2tog}, p_{ssso}, p₂*, repeat ** to last 8 sts, k_{1tbl}, p₂, k₂, sl₃ wyif

Row 10: k₂, kfb, p₂, k₂, p_{1tbl}, *k₂, p₁, yo, p₁, k₂, p_{1tbl}*, repeat ** to last 3 sts, sl₃ wyif (1 st increased)

Row 11: k₃, *k_{1tbl}, p₂, k₃, p₂*, repeat ** to last 9 sts, k_{1tbl}, p₂, k₃, sl₃ wyif



PATTERN INSTRUCTIONS cont'd

Row 12: k2, kfb, p3, k2, p1tbl, *k2, p3, k2, p1tbl*, repeat ** to last 3 sts, sl3 wyif (1 st increased)

Row 13: k3, *k1tbl, p2, k3tog, yo, p2*, repeat ** to last 10 sts, k1tbl, p2, k3tog, yo, p1, sl3wyif

Row 14: k2, kfb, k1, p1, yo, p1, k2, p1tbl, *k2, p1, yo, p1, k2, p1tbl*, repeat ** to last 3 sts, sl3 wyif (1 st increased)

Row 15: k3, *k1tbl, p2, k3, p2*, repeat ** to last 3 sts, sl3 wyif

Row 16: k2, kfb, *k2, p3, k2, p1tbl*, repeat ** to last 3 sts, sl3 wyif (1 st increased)

Rows 17 to 80: repeat Rows 1 to 16 **four** more times (63 sts)

Section 2

Row 1 (RS): k3, * k1tbl, p2, yo, sl1kw, k2tog, pssو, p2*, repeat ** to last 4 sts, k1tbl, sl3wyif

Row 2 (WS): k2, kfb, pm, p1tbl, *k2, p1, yo, p1, k2, p1tbl*, repeat ** to last 3 sts, sl3 wyif (64 sts)

Row 3: k3, *k1tbl, p2, k3, p2*, repeat ** to 1 st before marker, k1tbl, k1, sl3 wyif

Row 4: k2, kfb, k1, p1tbl, *k2, p3, k2, p1tbl*, repeat ** to last 3 sts, sl3wyif (65 sts)

Row 5: k3, * k1tbl, p2, k3tog, yo, p2*, repeat ** to 1 st before marker, k1tbl, k to last 3 sts, sl3 wyif

Row 6: k2, kfb, k1, sl1yo, p1tbl, *k2, p1, yo, p1, k2, p1tbl*, repeat ** to last 3 sts, sl3 wyif (66 sts)

Row 7: k3, *k1tbl, p2, k3, p2*, repeat ** to 1 st before marker, k1tbl, sm, brk, k to last 3 sts, sl3 wyif

Row 8: k2, kfb, k1, sl1yo, k1, p1tbl, *k2, p3, k2, p1tbl*, repeat ** to last 3 sts, sl3 wyif (67 sts)

Row 9: k3, * k1tbl, p2, yo, sl1kw, k2tog, pssو, p2*, repeat ** to 1 st before marker, k1tbl, *k1, brk*, repeat ** to last 5 sts, k2, sl3 wyif

Row 10: k2, kfb, *k1, sl1yo*, repeat ** to marker, p1tbl, *k2, p1, yo, p1, k2, p1tbl*, repeat ** to last 3 sts, sl3 wyif (1 st increased)

Row 11: k3, *k1tbl, p2, k3, p2*, repeat ** to 1 st before marker, k1tbl, *brk, k1*, repeat to last 4 sts, k1, sl3 wyif

Row 12: k2, kfb, *k1, sl1yo*, repeat to 1 st before marker, k1, p1tbl, *k2, p3, k2, p1tbl*, repeat ** to last 3 sts, sl3 wyif (1 st increased)

Row 13: k3, * k1tbl, p2, k3tog, yo, p2*, repeat ** to 1 st before marker, k1tbl, *k1, brk*, repeat to last 5 sts, k2, sl3wyif

Row 14: k2, kfb, *k1, sl1yo*, repeat to marker, p1tbl, *k2, p1, yo, p1, k2, p1tbl*, repeat ** to last 3 sts, sl3 wyif (1 st increased)

Row 15: k3, *k1tbl, p2, k3, p2*, repeat ** to 1 st before marker, k1tbl, *brk, k1*, repeat to last 4 sts, k1, sl3 wyif

Row 16: k2, kfb, *k1, sl1yo*, repeat to 1 st before marker k1, p1tbl, *k2, p3, k2, p1tbl*, repeat ** to last 3 sts, sl3 wyif (1 st increased) (71 sts)

Rows 17 to 216: repeat Rows 9 to 16 **twenty-five** more times (167 sts)

Bind Off

I-cord BO as follows: *k2, k2tog tbl, sl 3 sts back to LHN; repeat from * until 3 sts remain, k2tog, k1, sl 2 sts back to LHN, k2tog tbl, break yarn, leaving enough of a tail to weave in, pull tail through the last st and pull tight to close

Weave in ends, block to measurements
