## YARN TWISTERS

Sock Set Shawl<br>created by Lisa Overby



Fell in love with a gorgeous sock set but don't want to make socks? This is the pattern for you! A crescent shaped shawl that uses 1 skein of sock yarn and 1 mini for the border. Want a bigger shawl? Add another mini!

## MATERIALS \& INFO

Yarn: 1 skein Yarn Twisters Rylyn, 420 yards/115 g; 80\% SW Merino/20\% Nylon; Sample knit in colourway Montague; 1 skein Ancient Arts Socknado Twisters, 75 yards/20 g; 80\% Superwash Fine Merino/20\% Nylon; Sample knit in colourway Baby Aubergine
Gauge: 17 sts by 38 rows equals 4 " by 4 " in garter after blocking

Needles: 4 mm (US 6) 40" circular needles, or size needed to obtain gauge
Notions: stitch markers, darning needle
Finished size: Centre Depth: 14.4" (37cm); Wingspan: $55 "(140 \mathrm{~cm})$

## ABBREVIATIONS

BO - bind off
CO-cast on
k-knit
k2tog - knit 2 together; insert needle into the next 2 sts, knit the 3 sts together as one ( 1 st decreased)

LHN - left hand needle
p-purl
pm - place marker
RHN - right hand needle
RS - right side
sl - slip st purlwise
sm - slip marker
ssk - slip, slip, knit: slip 2 sts knit wise, one at a time, to the right hand needle, place sts back on left hand needle and knit them together through their back loops (1 st decreased)
st/sts - stitch/stitches
tbl - through the back loop
WS - wrong side
wyif - with yarn in front
yo - yarnover

## PATTERN INSTRUCTIONS

## Garter tab Cast On

With MC, CO on 3 sts
Knit 9 rows, do not turn work. Pick up 5 sts along edge ( 1 in each of the garter valleys), pick up 3 sts from the CO edge (11sts)

## Set up

Row 1 (RS): k3, yo, k1, pm, k1, yo, k1, yo, k1, pm, k1, yo, k3 (15 sts)

Row 2 and all WS rows: k3, k1tbl, k to marker, sm, sl1 wyif, $p$ to 1 st before marker, sl1 wyif, sm, $k$ to last 4 sts, k1tbl, k3

Row 3: k3, yo, $k$ to marker, sm, k1, yo, $k$ to 1 st before marker, yo, $k 1$, sm, $k$ to last 3 sts, yo, $k 3$ ( 19 sts)

Row 5: k3, yo, k to marker, sm, k1, yo, ssk, yo, k1, yo, k2tog, yo, k1, sm, k to last 3 sts, yo, k3 (23 sts)

Row 6: as Row 2

## Section 1

Row 1: k3, yo, k to marker, sm, k1, yo, *k1, yo, ssk, k1, k2tog, yo*, repeat ** to 2 sts before marker, k1, yo, k1, sm, $k$ to last 3 sts, yo, k3 (4 sts increased)

Row 2 and all WS rows: k3, k1tbl, k to marker, sm, sl1 wyif, $p$ to 1 st before marker, sl1 wyif, sm, $k$ to last 4 sts, k1tbl, k3

Row 3: k3, yo, k to marker, sm, k1, yo, k1, *k1, yo, ssk, k1, k2tog, yo*, repeat ** to 3 sts before marker, k2, yo, k1, sm, k to last 3 sts, yo, k3 (4 sts increased)

Row 5: k3, yo, k to marker, sm, k1, yo, k2tog, yo, *k1, yo, ssk, k1, k2tog, yo*, repeat ** to 4 sts before marker, k1, yo, ssk, yo, k1, sm, k to last 3 sts, yo, k3 (4 sts increased)

Row 7: k3, yo, k to marker, sm, k1, yo, k1, yo, ssk, *k1, k2tog, yo, k1, yo, ssk*, repeat ** to 5 sts before marker, k1, k2tog, yo, k1, yo, k1, sm, k to last 3 sts, yo, k3 (4 sts increased)

Row 9: k3, yo, k to marker, sm, k1, yo, k2, yo, ssk, *k1, k2tog, yo, k1, yo, ssk *, repeat ** to 6 sts before marker, k1, k2tog, yo, k2, yo, k1, sm, k to last 3 sts, yo, k3 (4 sts increased)

Row 11: k3, yo, k to marker, sm, k1, yo, k3, yo, ssk, *k1, k2tog, yo, k1, yo, ssk *, repeat ** to 7 sts before marker, k1, k2tog, yo, k3, yo, k1, sm, k to last 3 sts, yo, k3 (4 sts increased)

## Row 12: as Row 2

Rows 13 to 132: repeat Rows 1 to 12 ten more times, cut MC (287 sts)

## Border with CC

Row 1 with CC: k3, yo, k to marker, sm, k1, yo, $k$ to 1 st before marker, yo, k1, sm, $k$ to last 3 sts, yo, k3 (4 sts increased)

Row 2: k3, yo, k1tbl, k to marker, sm, sl1 wyif, k to 1 st before marker, sl1 wyif, sm, k to last 4 sts, k1tbl, yo, k3 ( 2 sts, increased)

Row 3: k3, yo, k1tbl, k to marker, sm, k1, yo, k to 1 st before marker, yo, k1, sm, $k$ to last 4 sts, k1tbl, yo, k3 (4 sts increased)

Row 4: k3, yo, k1tbl, k to marker, sm, sl1 wyif, k to 1 st before marker, sl1 wyif, sm, $k$ to last 4 sts, k1tbl, yo, k3 ( 2 sts, increased)

Rows 5 to 12: repeat Rows 3 and 4 four more times, cut CC (323 sts)

## Bind Off with MC

BO all sts in the following manner to ensure a stretchy edge: k1, *k1, insert LHN into the 2 sts on the RHN, knit the 2 sts together through the back loop, repeat from * until all sts have been bound off

Weave in ends, block to measurements
