

## Checkers created by Lisa Overby



Mosaic knitting is a great colourwork technique to create geometric patterns in your knits while only knitting with one colour at a time. This hat is a great introduction to learning mosaic knitting.



## **MATERIALS & INFO**

Yarn: 2 balls Double Sunday by Sandnes Garn; 108 m/50 grams; 100% merino wool

Colour 1 (C1): 5581 (darker)

Colour 2 (C2): 3521 (lighter)

Gauge: 20 sts by 36 Rnds equal 4" by 4" in mosaic

pattern in the round after blocking

Needles: 3.5 mm (US 4) and 4 mm (US 6) 16" circular needle and 4 mm (US 6) DPN or long circular needle for magic loop; or size needed to obtain gauge

Notions: stitch marker, darning needle, pompom (optional)

Finished size: Circumference 19"; Height 9"

Notes:

One size only, but size can be adjusted by increasing or decreasing stitches in multiples of 4

Sample used approx 42 grams of C1 and 15 grams of C2

## **ABBREVIATIONS**

**BOR** - beginning of Rnd

CO - cast on

k - knit

**k2tog** - knit 2 together; insert needle into the next 2 sts, knit the 2 sts together as one (1 st decreased)

**p**- purl

Rnd - round

sl - slip

**st/sts** - stitch/stitches

wyib - with yarn in back

## **PATTERN INSTRUCTIONS**

With smaller needles and C1, CO 92 sts, join to knit in the Rnd, careful to not twist your sts, place marker to denote the BOR

Ribbing

Rnd 1: \*k2, p2\*, repeat \*\* to end of Rnd

Repeat Rnd 1 until ribbing measures 2"

Body (switch to larger needles)

Rnds 1 & 2: k

Rnds 3 & 4 with C2: \*k2, sl2 wyib\*, repeat \*\* to end of Rnd

Rnds 5 & 6 with C1: k

Rnds 7 & 8 with C2: \*sl2 wyib, k2\*, repeat \*\* to end of

Rnd

Rnds 9 to 64: repeat Rnds 1 to 8 seven more times

Decreases (switch to DPN's or longer circular needle for magic loop when sts no longer fit comfortably on the 16" needle) Rnd 1 with C1: \*k2tog, k2\*, repeat \*\* to end of Rnd (69 sts)

Rnd 2: k

Rnds 3 & 4 with C2: \*k1, sl2 wyib\*, repeat \*\* to end of Rnd

Rnd 5 with C1: \*k1, k2tog\*, repeat \*\* to end of Rnd (46 sts)

**Rnd 6:** k

Rnds 8 & 7 with C2: \*sl1 wyib, k1\*, repeat \*\* to end of Rnd, cut C2

Rnd 9: \*k2tog\*, repeat \*\* to end of Rnd (23sts)

**Rnd 10:** \*k2tog\*, repeat \*\* to last st, k1 (12 sts)

Rnd 11: \*k2tog\*, repeat \*\* to end of Rnd (6 sts)

**Finishing** 

Cut yarn, leaving a 6" tail, thread through remaining sts and pull tight to close the hole, weave in ends and block hat to relax the sts
