This hat was designed to showcase our Kelton yarn base, a luxurious 100\% 17 Micron Count Superwash Wool. With 3 sizes to choose from, this quick knit would make a perfect gift for that knit worthy person in your life!

## MATERIALS \& INFO

Yarn: 1 skein Yarn Twisters Kelton; 210 yards/115g; 100\% 17 Micron Count Superwash Wool

Sample knit in colourway Raspberry
Gauge: 18 sts by 31 Rnds equal 4 " by 4 " in off set rib pattern in the round after blocking

Needles: 4 mm (US 6) 16" circular needle and 4 mm (US 6) DPN's or long circular needle for magic loop; or size needed to obtain gauge

Notions: stitch marker, darning needle, pom pom (optional)

Finished size unstretched:
Small: Circumference 14" (33 cm); Height 9" ( 23 cm )
Medium: Circumference 17" ( 43 cm ); Height 9.5" (24 cm)

Large: Circumference 18" (46 cm); Height 10" ( 25 cm )
Note:
Be sure to follow the decrease instructions for the size of hat you are knitting

To wear this slouchy hat beanie style, fold the brim once

## ABBREVIATIONS

cdd - centre double decrease; slip 2 stitches as if to k2tog, knit 1, pass 2 slipped stitches together over the knit stitch (2 sts decreased)

CO- cast on
k - knit
k2tog - knit 2 together; insert needle into the next 2 sts, knit the 2 sts together as one ( 1 st decreased)
pm - place marker
p-purl
Rnd - round
st/sts - stitch/stitches

## PATTERN INSTRUCTIONS

CO $70(80,90)$ sts, join to knit in the Rnd, careful to not twist your sts, pm to denote the beginning of the Rnd

## Off-Set Ribbing, All Sizes

Rnd 1: p1, k1
Rnd 2: k1, p1, repeat to end of Rnd
Rnds 3 to 6: repeat Rnd 2 four times
Rnds 7 to 11: repeat Rnd 1 five times
Rnds 12 to 31: repeat Rnds 2 to 11 two times
Rnd 32: k
Repeat Rnd 32 until hat measures approx $7.5(8,8.5)$ " from the CO edge

## Decreases, Small Size

Rnd 1: k6, cdd, [k11, cdd] x 4, k5 (60 sts)
Rnd 2 and every other even Rnd: k
Rnd 3: k5, cdd, [k9, cdd] $\times 4$, k4, (50 sts)
Rnd 5: k4, cdd, [k7, cdd] x 4, k3 (40 sts)
Rnd 7: k3, cdd, [k5, cdd] x 4, k2 (30 sts)
Rnd 9: k2, cdd, [k3, cdd] x 4, k1 (20 sts)
Rnd 11: k1, cdd, [k1, cdd] $\times 4$ (10 sts)
Rnd 13: k2tog x 5 ( 5 sts)

## PATTERN INSTRUCTIONS

## Decreases, Medium Size

Rnd 1: k7, cdd, [k13, cdd] x 4, k6 (70 sts)
Rnd 2 and every other even Rnd: $k$
Rnd 3: k6, cdd, [k11, cdd] x 4, k5 (60 sts)
Rnd 5: k5, cdd, [k9, cdd] x 4, k4 (50 sts)
Rnd 7: k4, cdd, [k7, cdd] x 4, k3 (40 sts)
Rnd 9: k3, cdd, [k5, cdd] x 4, k2 (30 sts)
Rnd 11: k2, cdd, [k3, cdd] x 4, k1 (20 sts)
Rnd 13: k1, cdd, [k1, cdd] x 4 (10 sts)
Rnd 15: k2tog $x 5$ ( 5 sts )

Decreases, Large Size
Rnd 1: k8 cdd, [k15, cdd] x 4, k7 (80 sts)
Rnd 2 and every other even Rnd: $k$
Rnd 3: k7, cdd, [k13, cdd] x 4, k6 (70 sts)
Rnd 5: k6, cdd, [k11, cdd] x 4, k5 (60 sts)
Rnd 7: k5, cdd, [k9, cdd] x 4, k4 (50 sts)
Rnd 9: k4, cdd, [k7, cdd] x 4, k3 (40 sts)
Rnd 11: k3, cdd, [k5, cdd] x 4, k2 (30 sts)
Rnd 13: k2, cdd, [k3, cdd] x 4, k1 (20 sts)
Rnd 15: k1, cdd, [k1, cdd] x 4 (10 sts)
Rnd 17: k2tog $x 5$ (5 sts)

## Finishing, All sizes

Cut yarn, leaving a 6" tail, thread through remaining sts and pull tight to close the hole, weave in ends

Block piece (optional), attach a pom pom (optional)
